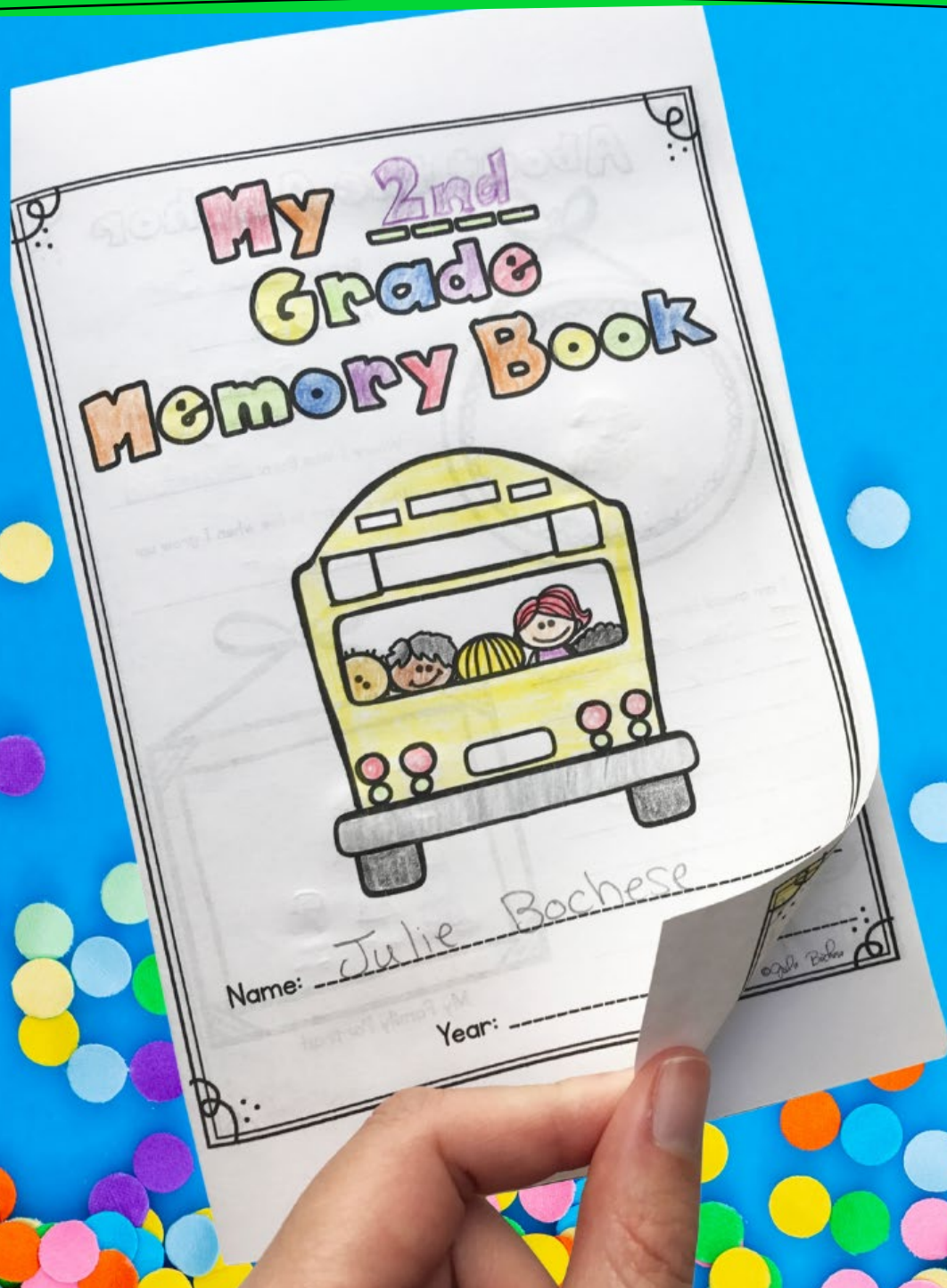

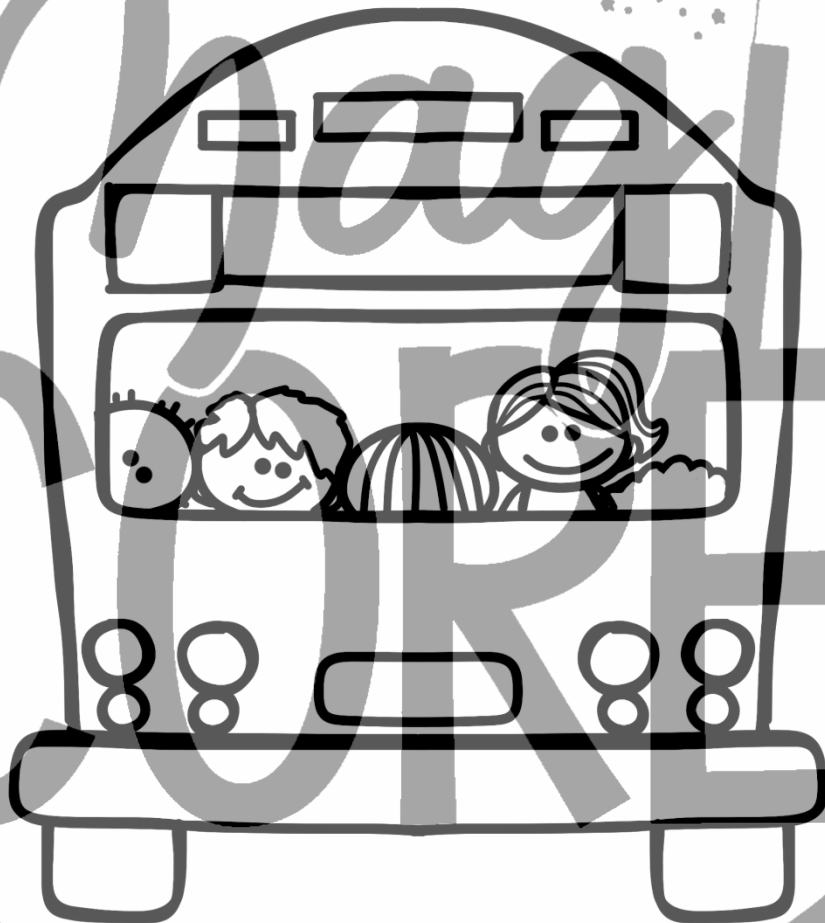


# Why a Memory Book?

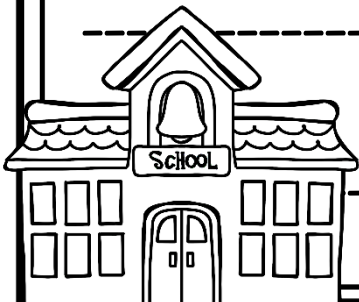

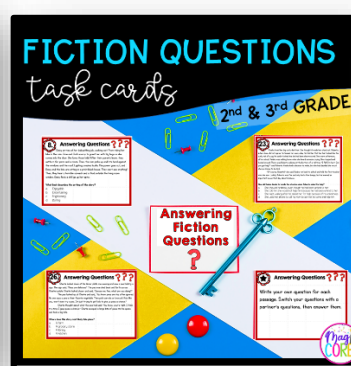
