There are two types of questions.

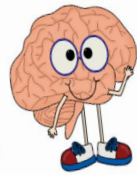
1. "RIGHT THERE" QUESTIONS

You need to use details in the text plus your brain to infer the answers.



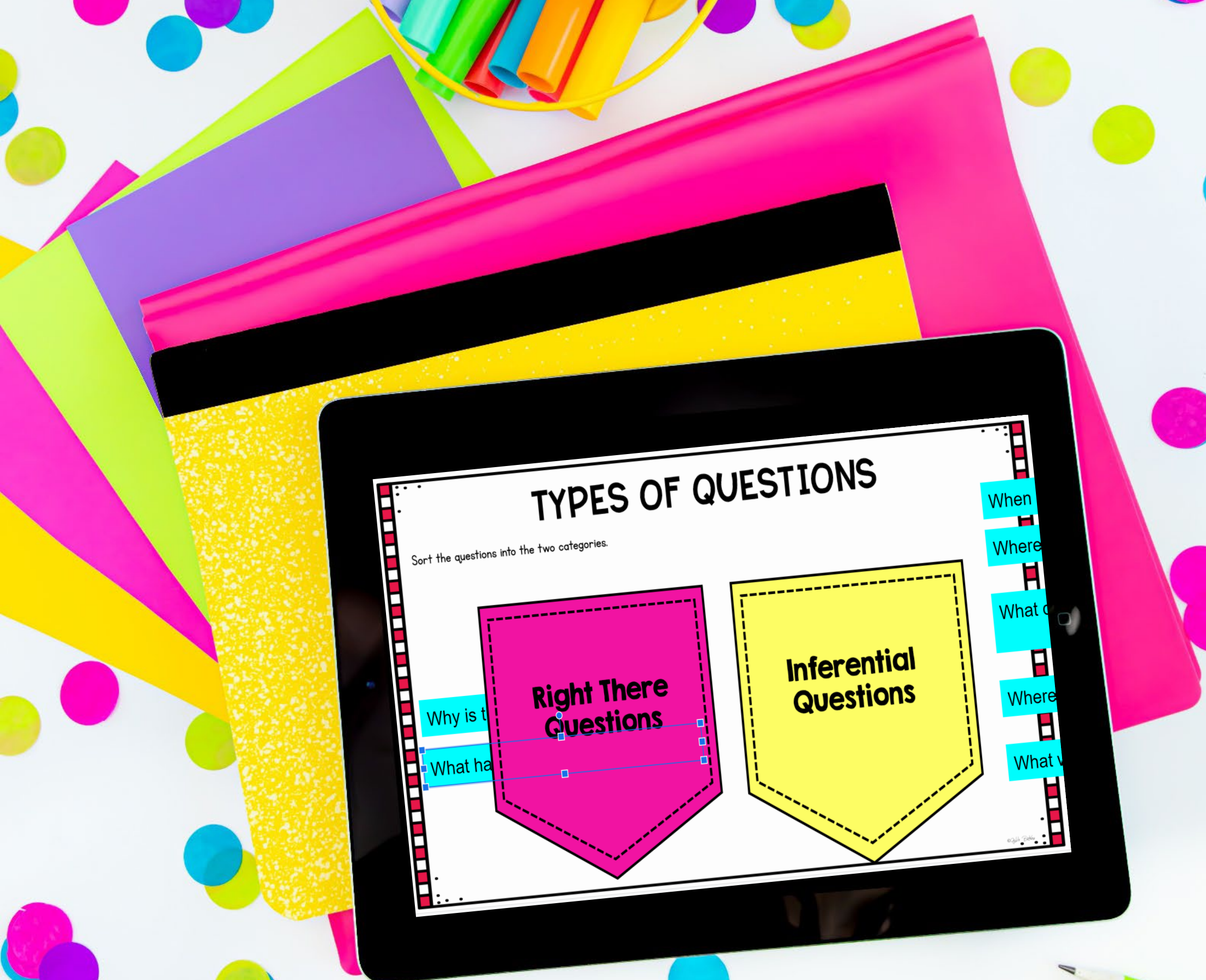

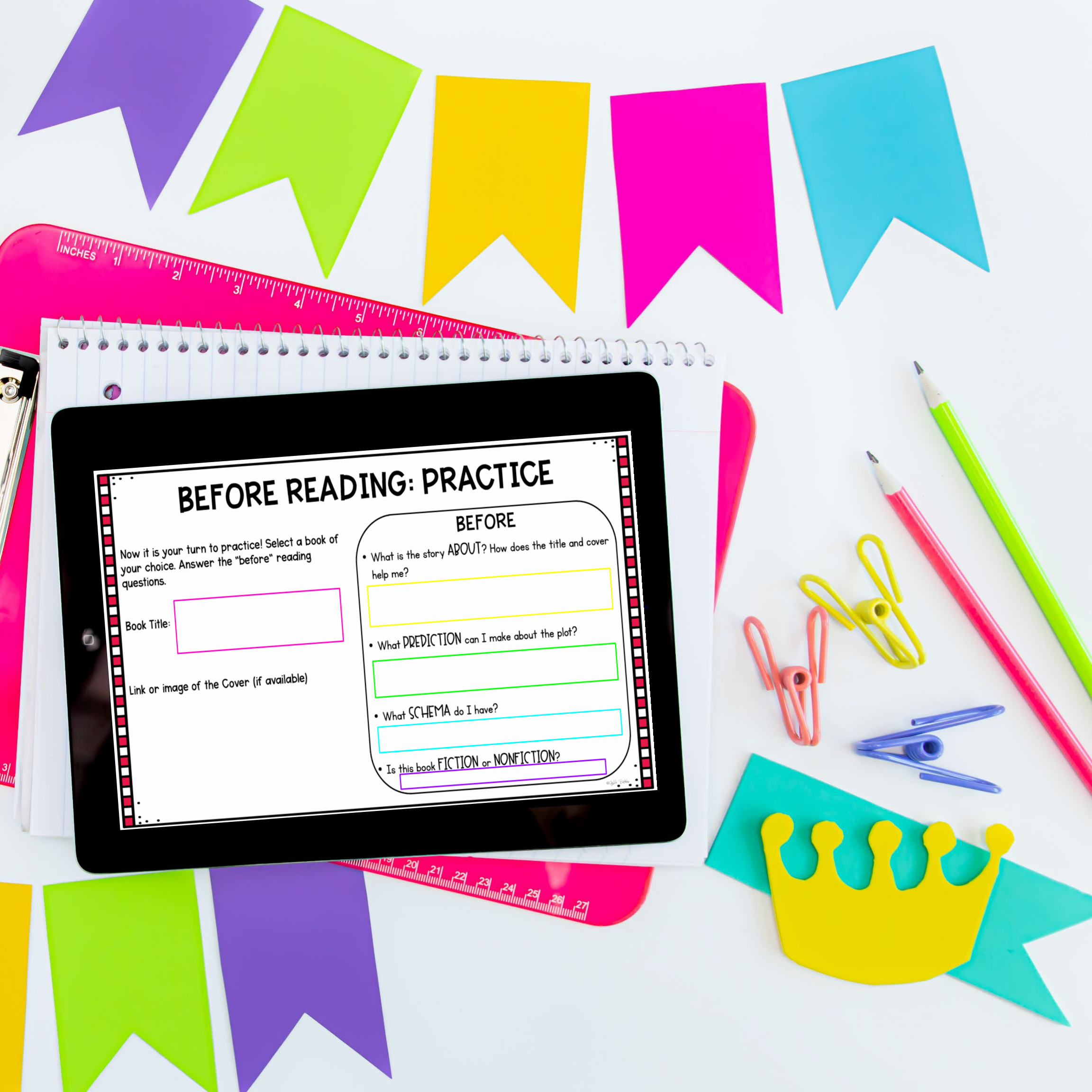
