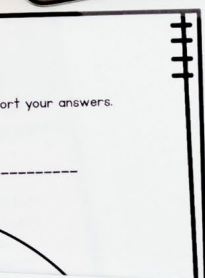


"Now, which trail should we visit first?" asked Julia. "I say we start things off at the South Rim Trail"
