

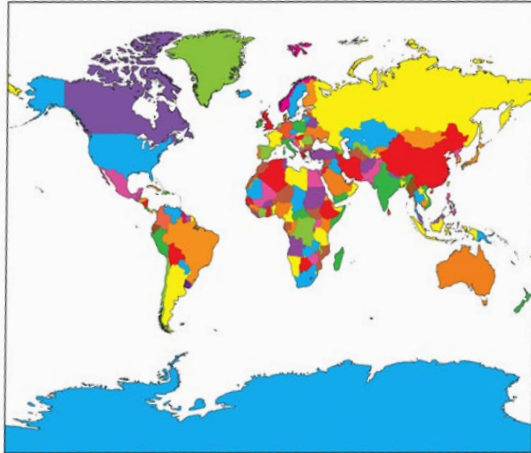

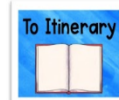

The saree is a traditional dress for Indian women. The fabric is wrapped around the waist while the other end is draped over the shoulder.

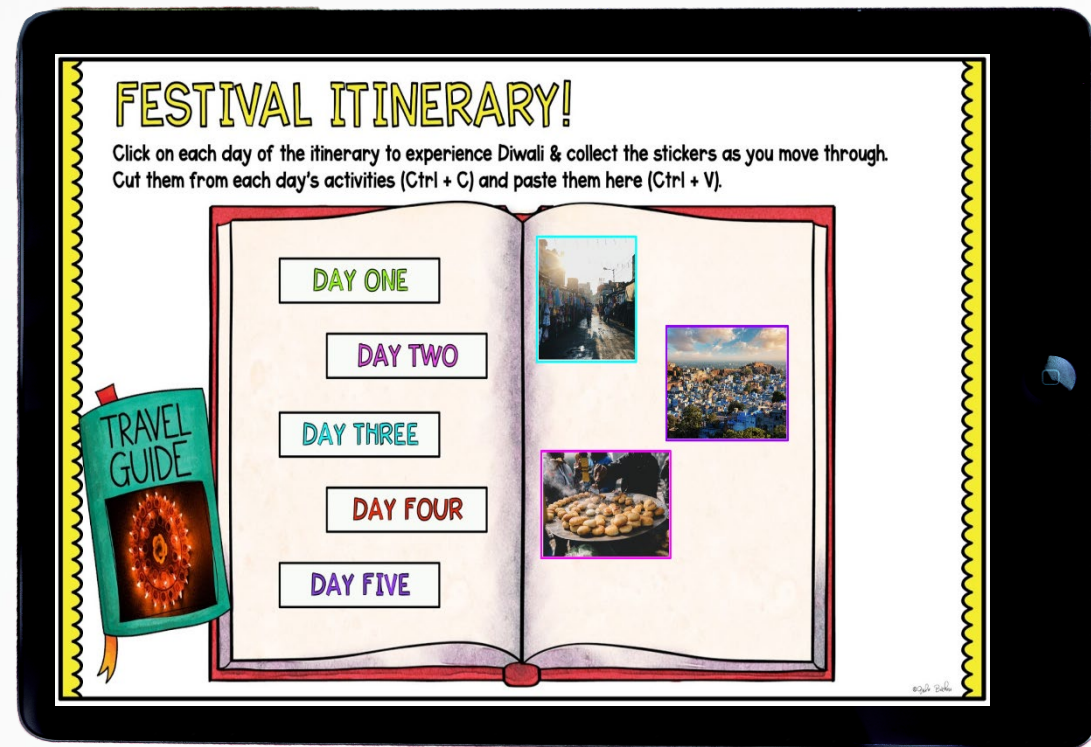
