Travel to Jerusalem to collect stickers for important symbols related to Hanukkah.





Let's Explore!: Jerusalem



Jerusalem is one of the oldest cities in the world that people have lived in continuously. It is important to many major religions, including the Jewish, Christian, and Islamic faiths. There are about 1204 synagogues, 158 churches, and 73 mosques within the city.

Jerusalem is the capital of both Israel and Palestine, under their laws. However, most other countries disagree. Most countries have their embassies with Israel in Tel Aviv. Jerusalem is about 40 miles east of the Mediterranean Sea. It is a hilly city with many valleys around it. Hebrew is the country's official latigations.
