


Optional: If you want to add a fun spin on this activity, have students make and decorate their own shopping bag to store their work.

Materials:

- Craft paper or butcher paper (preferably in a large size, e.g., 18x24 inches)

- Markers, colored pencils, or crayons
- Stickers (optional)


Preparation:

- Pre-cut the craft paper into large rectangles, depending on the desired size of the shopping bag. For example, for a medium-sized bag, an 18x24 inch rectangle works well.
- Set up a station with all the necessary materials: craft paper, scissors, glue, hole punch, markers, ribbon/yarn, and stickers.
- Explain to the students that they'll be creating their own shopping bags for the PBL project. Show them a sample, if available, to give them an idea of what they'll be making.





