LET'S EXPLORE! Three Kings Day

Three Kings Day is a Christian holiday that is celebrated twelve days after Christmas on January 6th every year. It marks the end of the Christmas season and is a time to remember the Three Kings who visited the baby Jesus. In the biblical story, the Three Kings followed a star to find the baby and brought gifts to celebrate his birth. This winter holiday is very important in many countries, including Puerto Rico, Spain, and Mexico. Communities celebrate with parades and feasts. This is the day that family members exchange gifts with one another. Children leave out their shoes the night before in hopes that the Three Kings will fill them with presents.



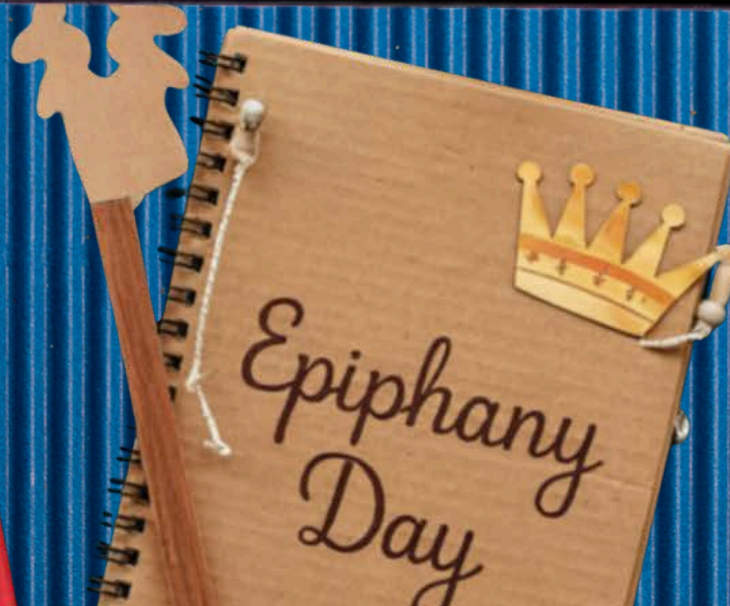



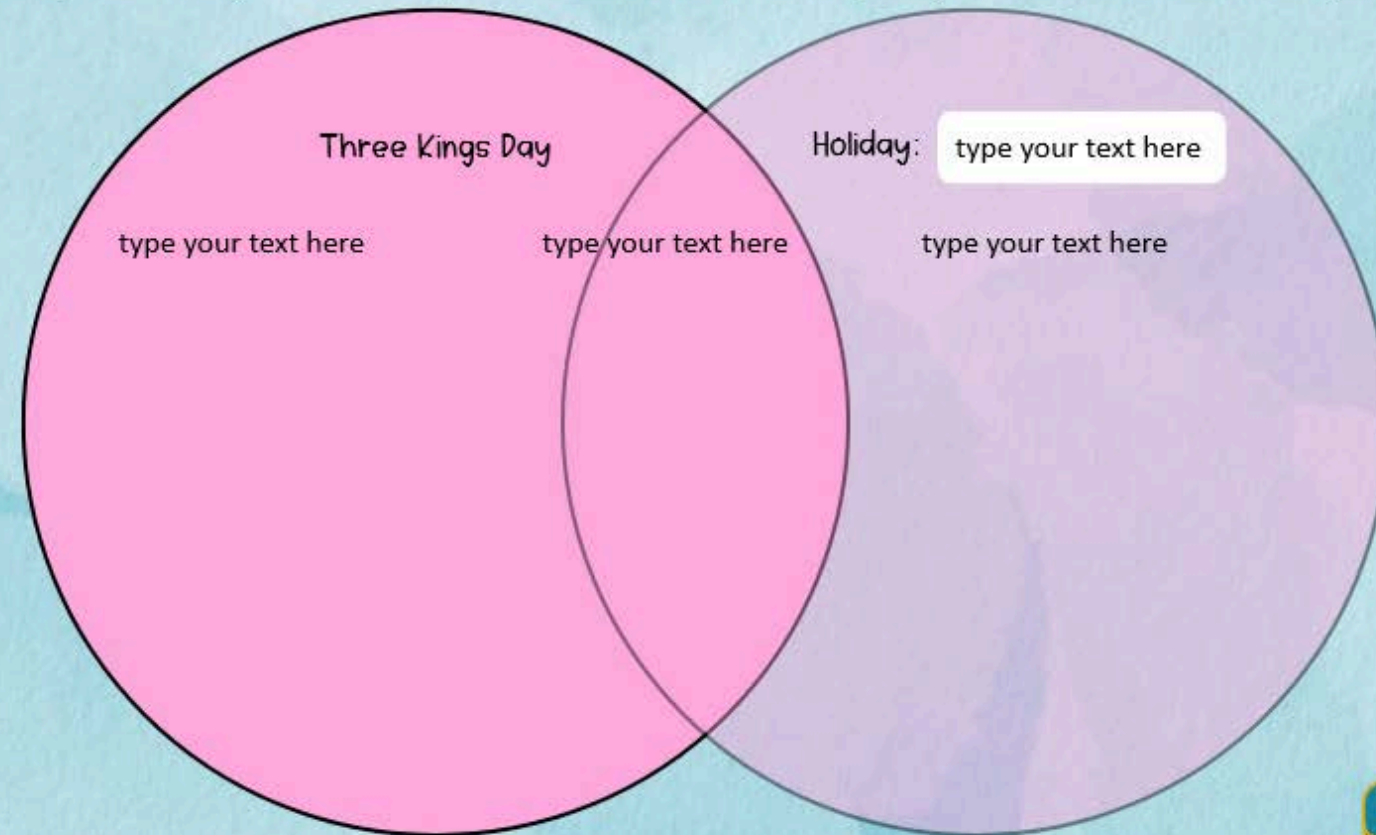

The Three Kings are also known as The Three Wise Men or The Magi. Watch the video to learn more about who they were.

What did they study?

They saw a bright new star in the sky, which they believed was a sign of the birth of a great ruler, so they decided to follow it.

What gifts did they bring?
They brought gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

People thought they were kings because they brought valuable gifts and traveled a long distance to honor Jesus.
