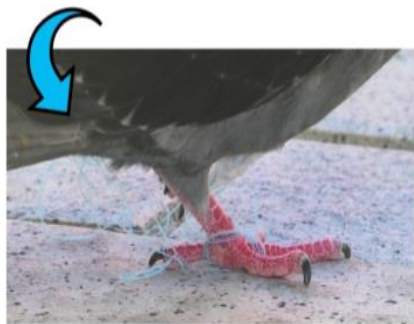
INTERDISCIPLINARY

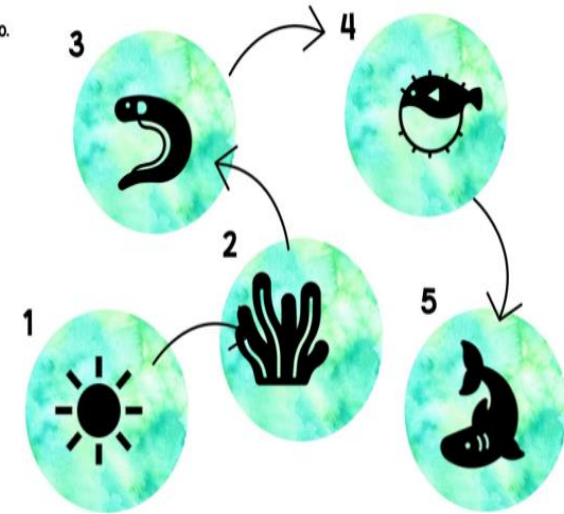

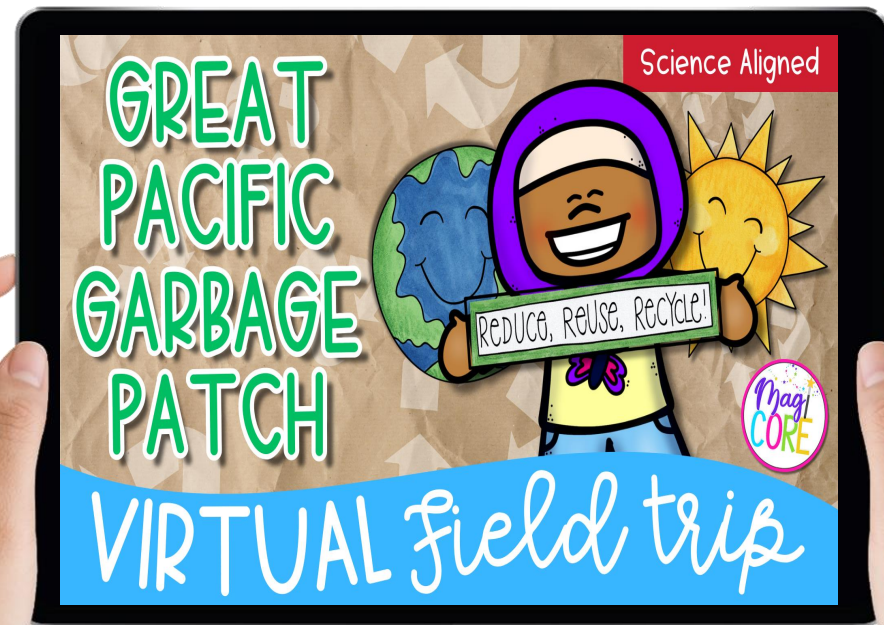
