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

#### Find the Main Idea

Garbage doesn't just go away when it is picked up by the sanitation truck. The plastic that goes into landfills takes hundreds of years to break down. A dump truck worth of plastic is thrown into the ocean every minute. Trading in shampoo bottles

for bar shampoo is one way to use less plastic. Putting food in glass or metal containers instead of plastic bags helps, too. Avoiding plastic straws, water bottles, and items with excess packaging will reduce the plastic in landfills. Being creative and changing wasteful habits can help reduce plastic pollution.





### Find the Main Idea (Passage)

What is more comforting than a steaming cup of hot chocolate? Hot chocolate is a heated drink made with shaved or melted chocolate or cocoa powder with warm milk or water and sugar. But did you know this popular drink has been around for about 3,000 years?

The Maya people likely created the first chocolate drink in 500 BC. That was almost 3,000 years ago! The Mayas served their chocolate drink cold. To make this drink, the Mayas ground cocoa seeds into a paste, which was mixed with water, cornmeal, and chili peppers. The drink was then poured from cup to cup to form a thick foam.

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A chocolate drink called xocōlātl became a large part of the Aztec culture in 1400 AD. Sugar was not available yet, so this drink tasted vastly different from today's chocolate drinks. The chocolate base was mixed with vanill spices, giving it a bitter and spicy flavor. It is lik Aztecs were the first to serve their xocōlātl he beans were used as currency, and having this dr high status.
