Veterinarians are doctors who provide care for animals. They help sick or injured animals recover, and help healthy animals stay healthy! Vets work in many settings with all different types of animals.

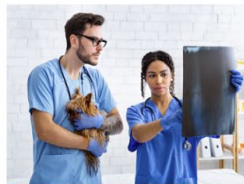
Place the heart next to the type of animals you would choose to care for.



Some vets work with farm animals on ranches and farms.



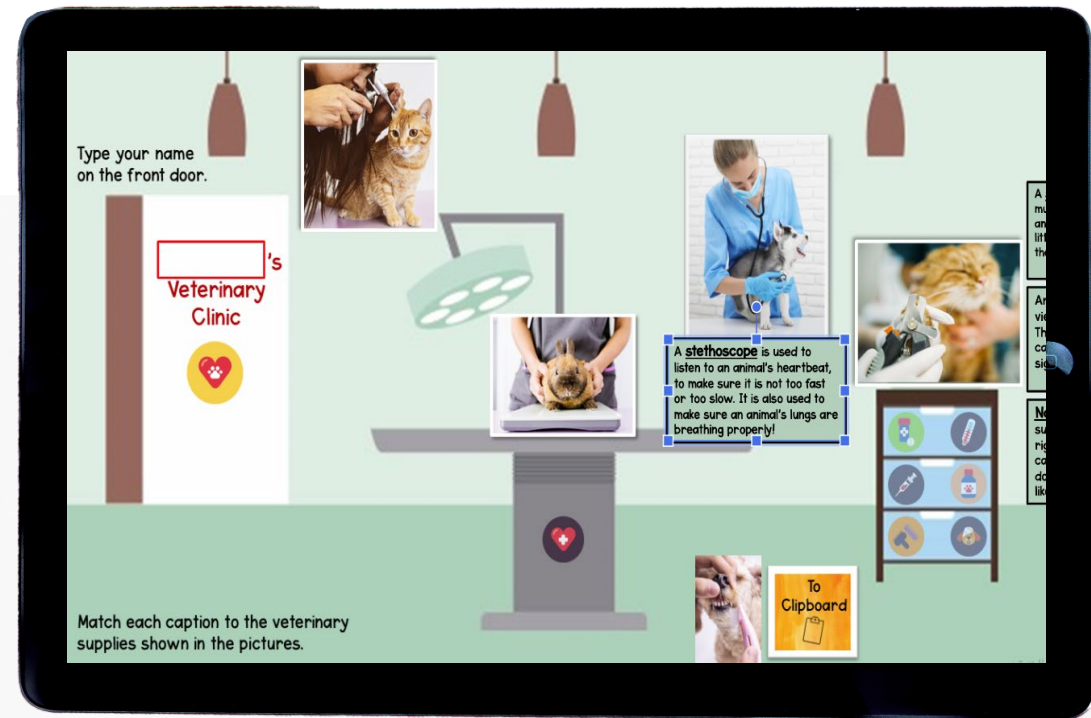
Some vets work with wild animals at zoos or wildlife centers.

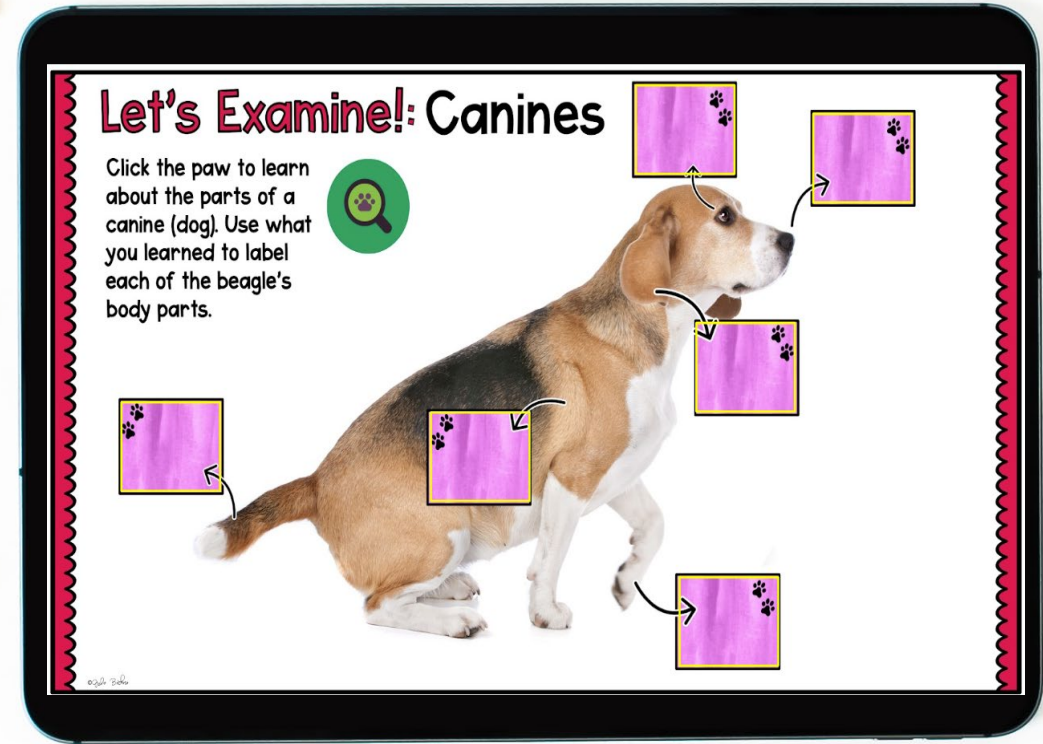

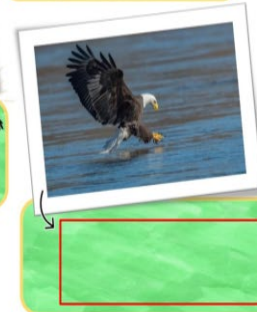

Let's Examine!: Raptors

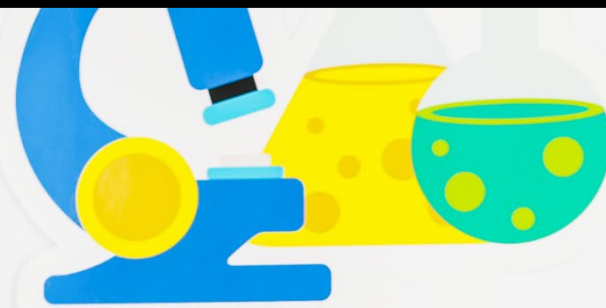
Read the text. Write a caption for each picture using details from the text.

Bald Eagles are a kind of raptor! A typical adult's wingspan is between 6-7 feet wide, and their main source of nutrition is fish. Because they have great eyesight, they can see a fish in open water from hundreds of feet in the air. Then they quickly dive toward the water at (up to) 100mph to catch the fish in their long, strong talons.
