Stop #15: USS Constitution

The USS Constitution is the oldest commissioned warship in the world. She was launched in 1797 from a Boston shipyard. Constitution was one of six original frigates that formed the core of the fledgling United States Navy in the 1790s. She earned a reputation in battle by defeating four British frigates during the War of 1812. Today, she is America's "Ship of State." On special occasions, she has turn-around cruises in Boston Harbor.
