What is a Butterfly Garden?

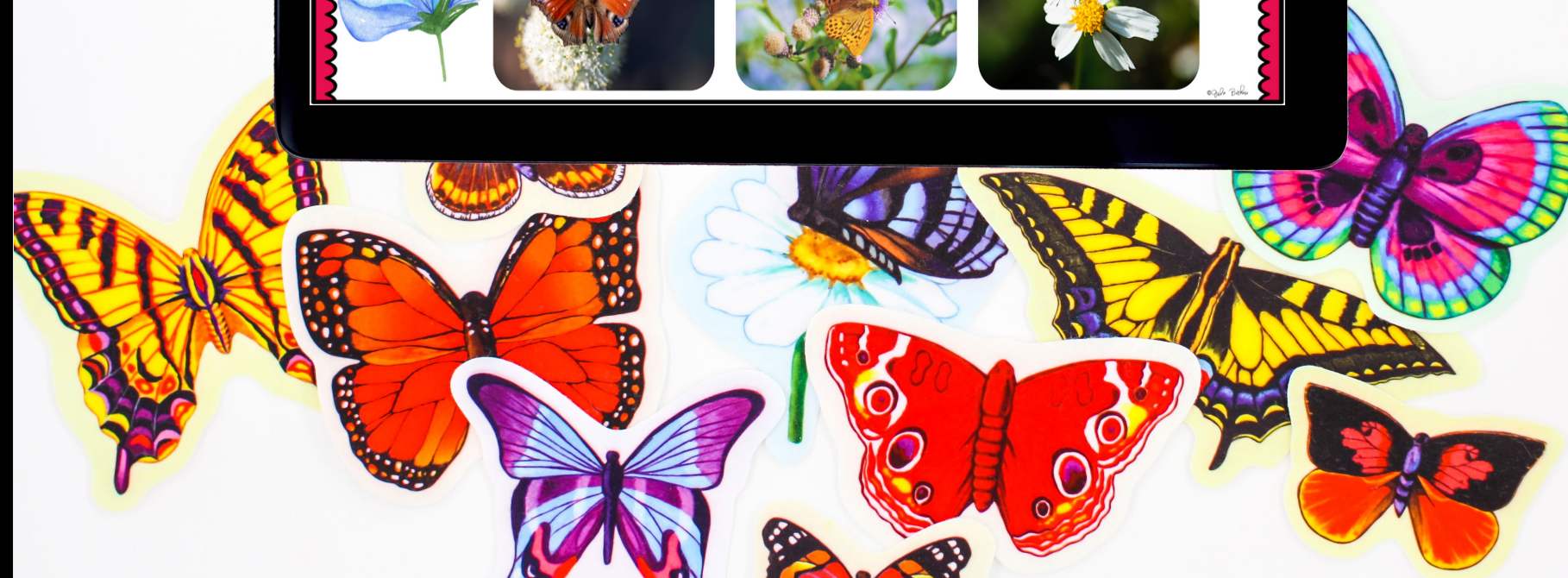
