
Walter Disney was born December 5, 1901 in Illinois. He is best known for his work in animation and the creation of Mickey Mouse. Along with his brother, Roy Disney, he was the founder of The Walt Disney Company.

When he was young, Disney took classes at the Chicago Art Institute. He drew pictures for the school newspaper. At sixteen, he wanted to help fight in World War I. He was too young to join the army, so he dropped out of school and joined the Red Cross. He spent the next year driving ambulances in France.

Disney was once fired from a newspaper company in Kansas City, Missouri because of his lack of creativity. He went on to become an extraordinary animator and business owner. He is well-known as a film nducer and a theme park designer. He and his staff ted some of the world's most well-known

ted Walt Disney Studios and was the original voice for Mickey ed the first full-length animated movie Snow White and the 1937. The movie was a huge success. The money he earned te many more cartoons and movies. He won 22 Academy erecord for winning four Academy Awards in one year. n Emmy Awards. 




