A **savanna** is a type of land on Earth. Savannas are warm all year long. Savannas are very dry for most of the year. They can be very wet in the summer.



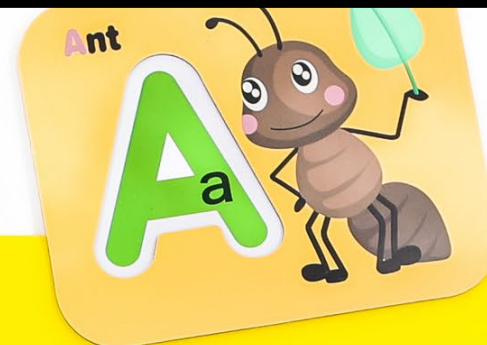
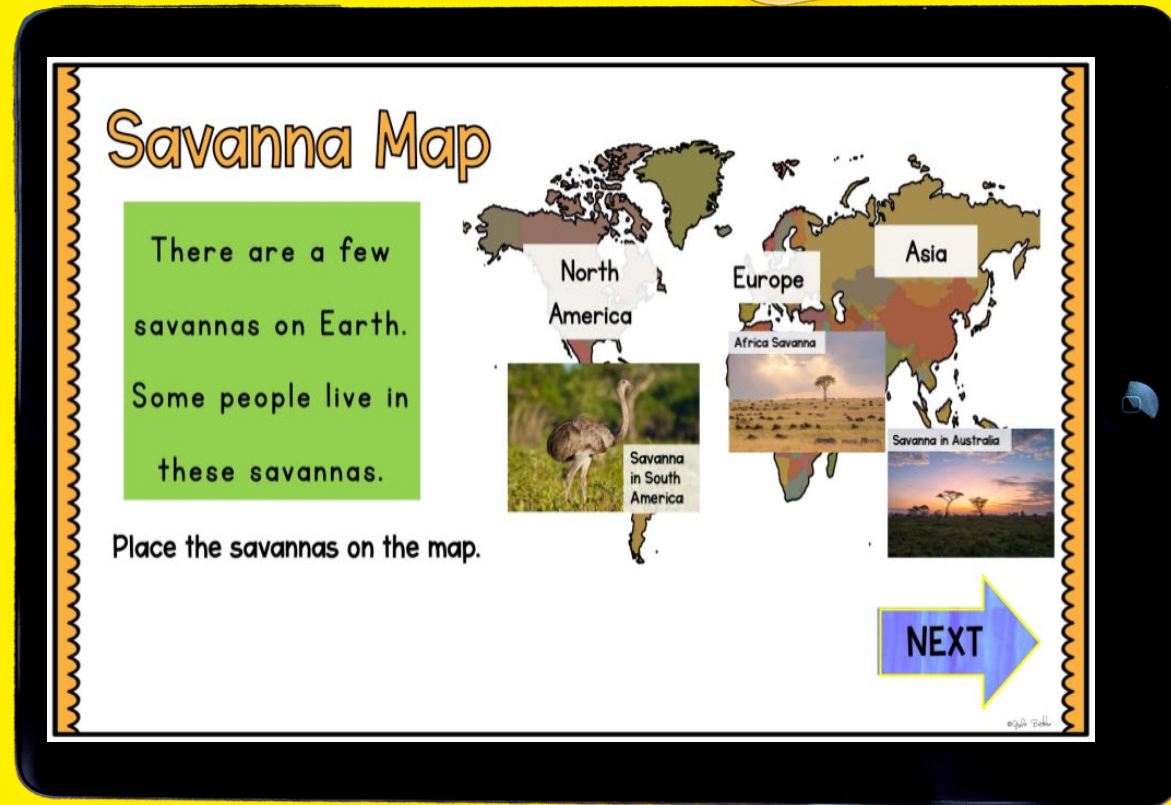
