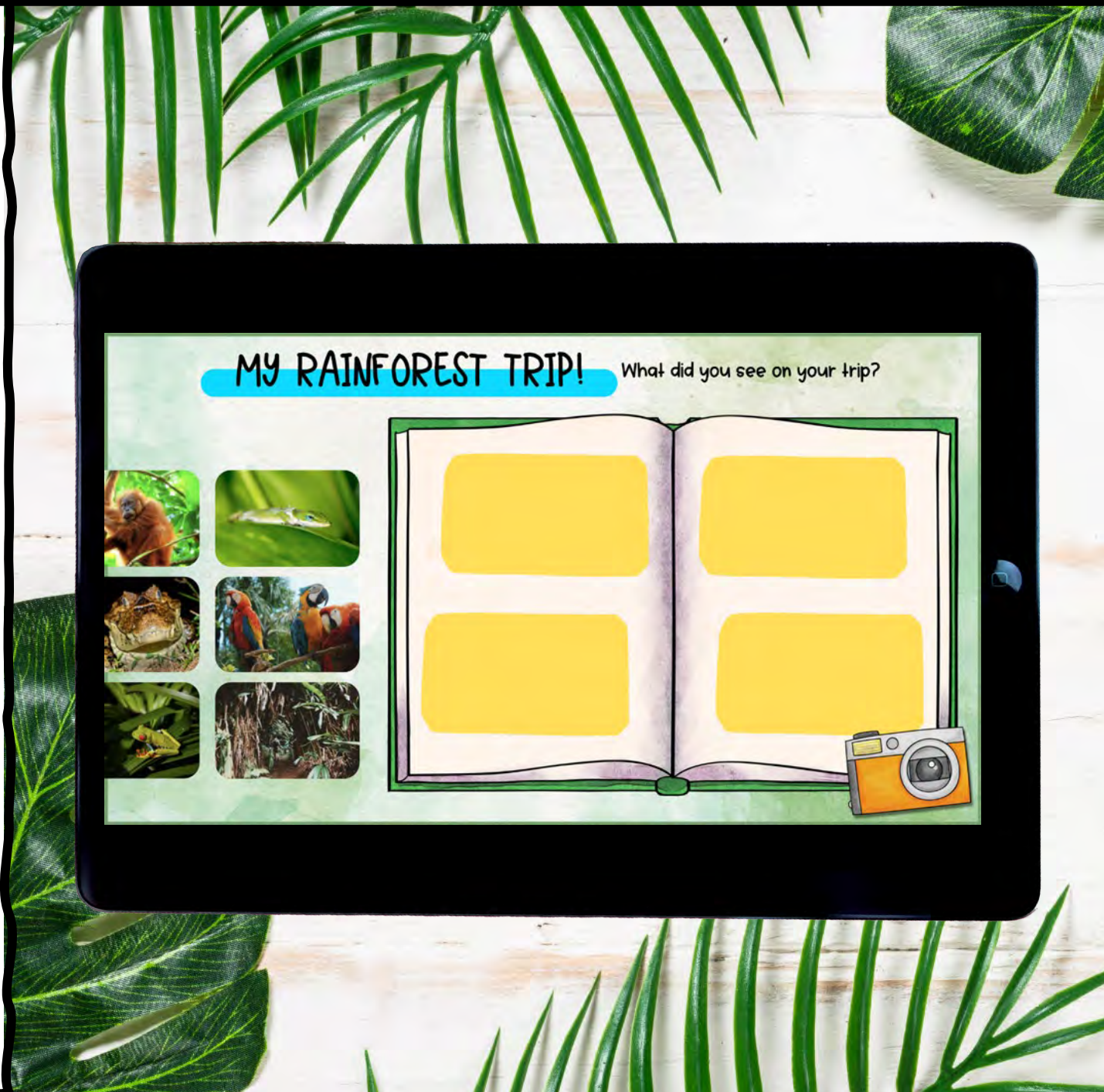

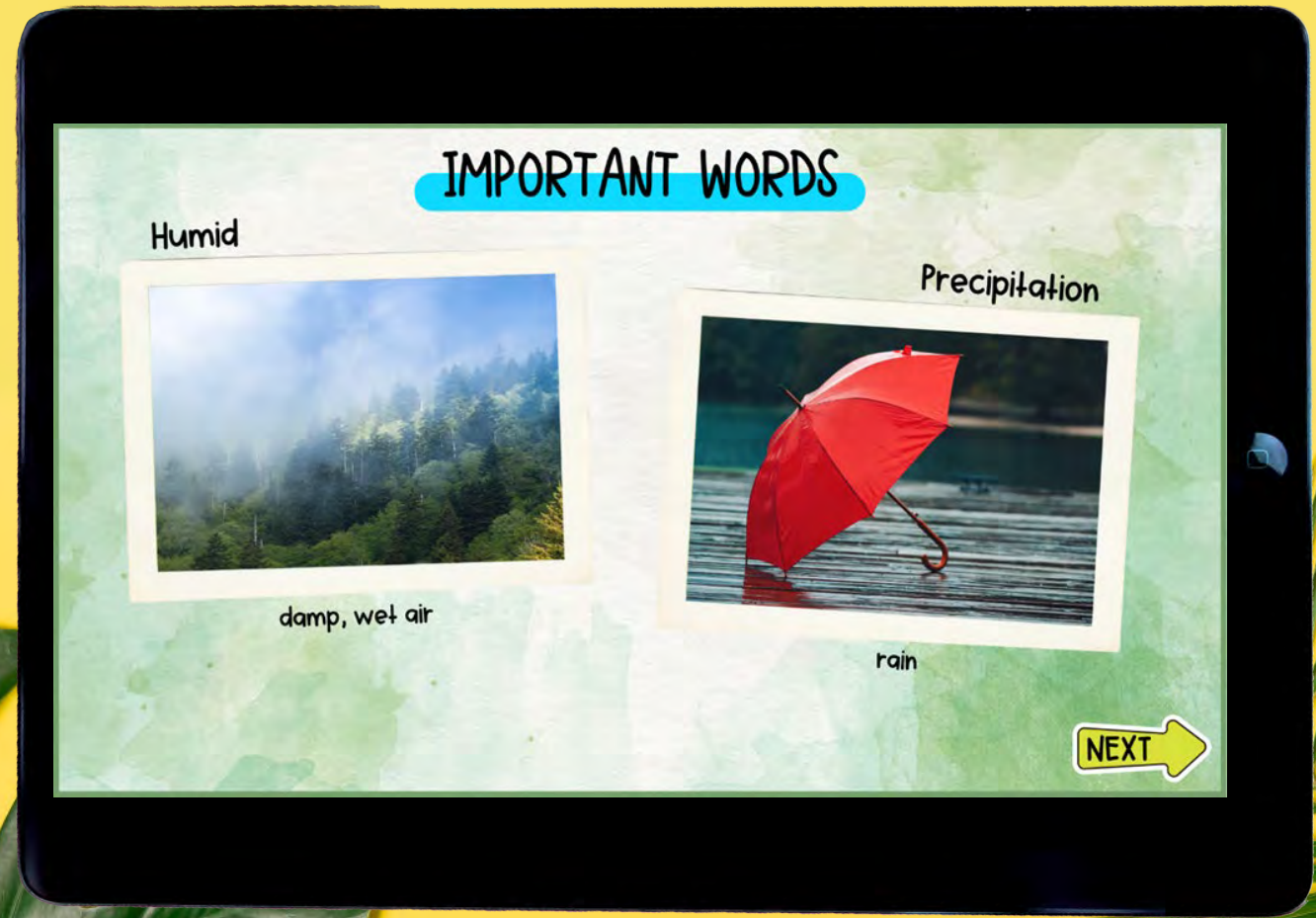

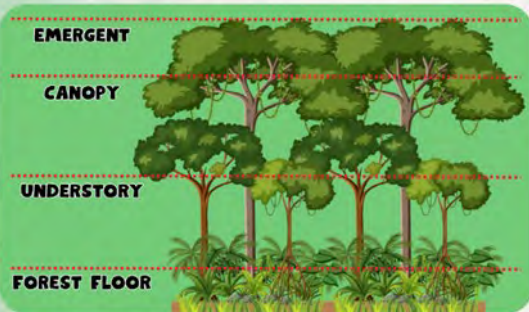

Which layer of the Rainforest does the Toucan live in? Place the Toucan in the right layer.

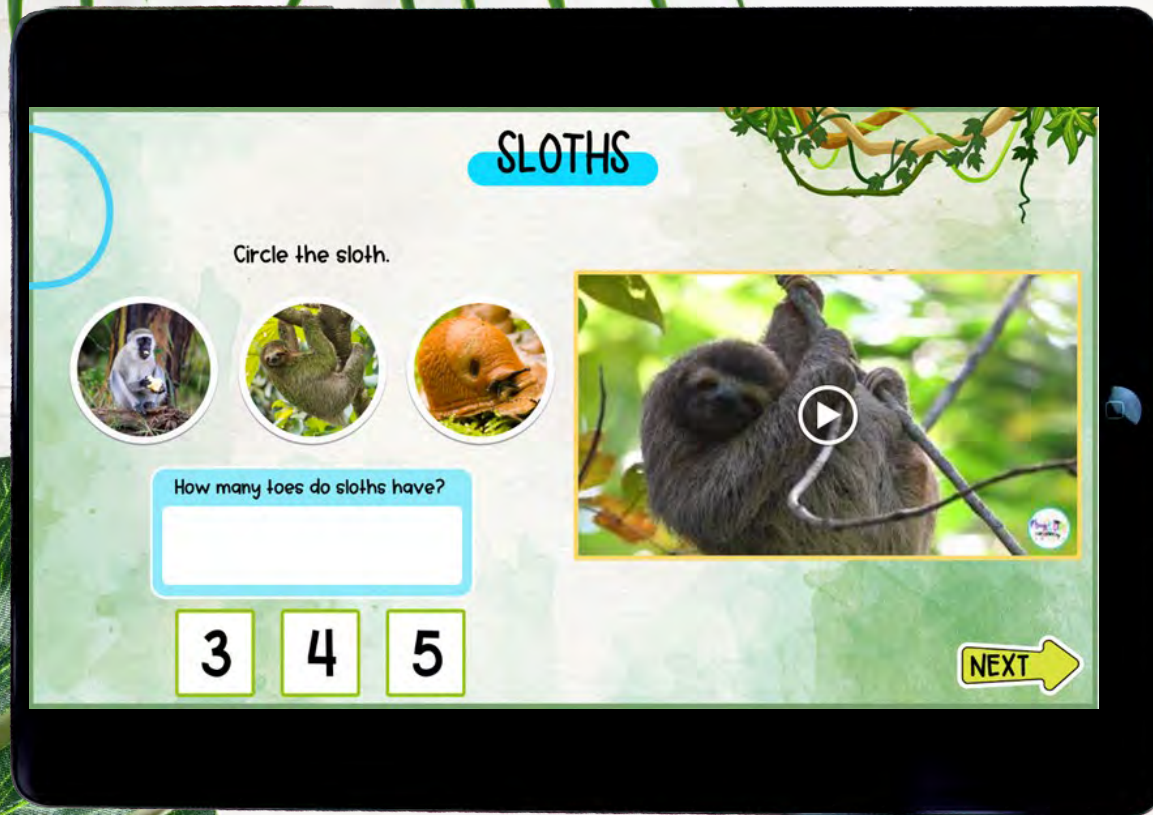


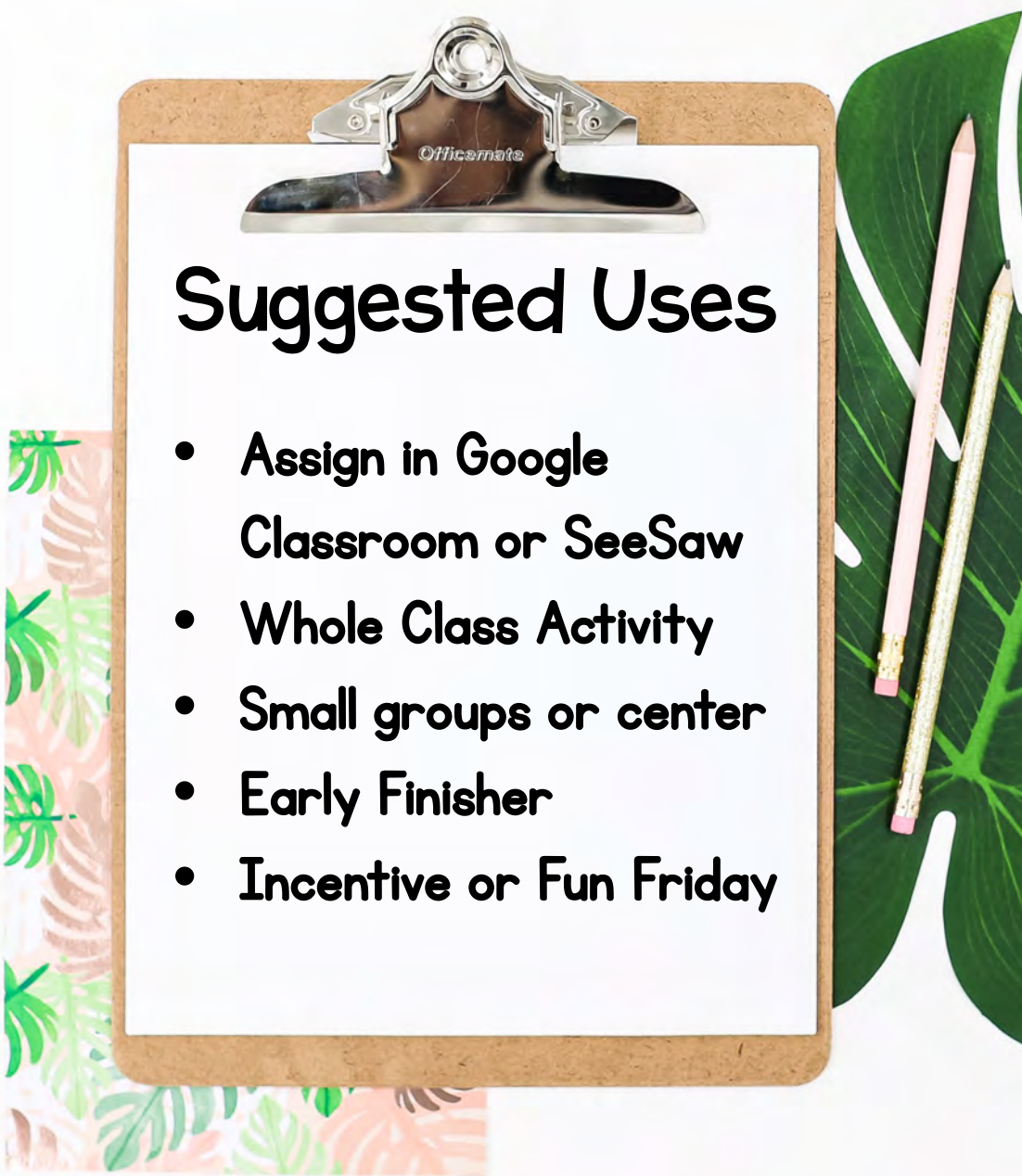
