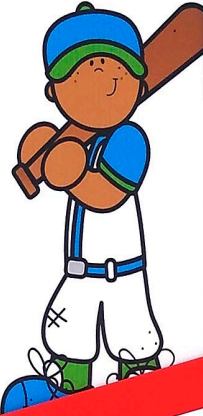

6. Text Structure

Many athletes have had injuries to their ligaments. This can be avoided by stretching before playing sports. A ligament joins bones together. Bones and ligaments form joints. Ligaments are only slightly elastic. If ligaments are pulled, they get longer. If ligaments get too long, they will be weak. Athletes use stretching exercises to lengthen their ligaments in a safe way. This limits the possibility of injury to the joint.

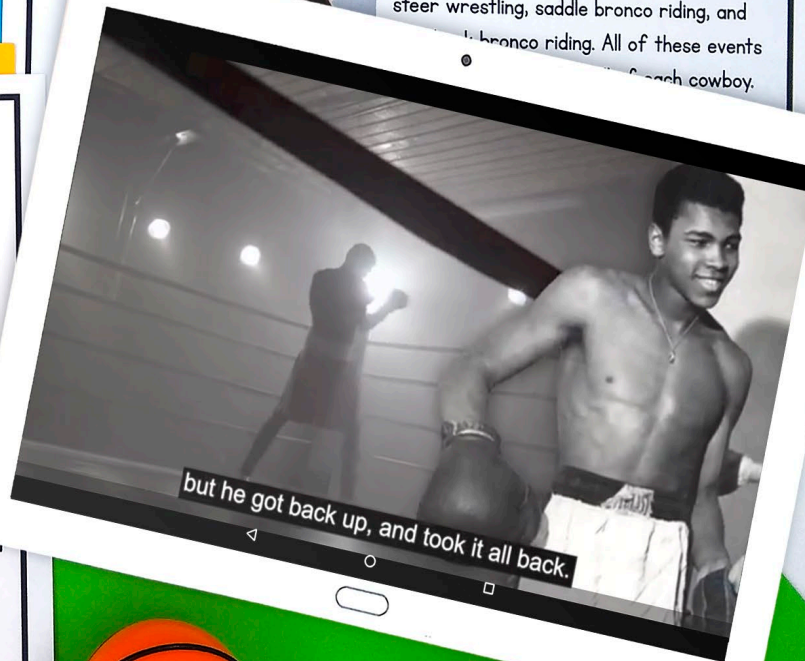


Text Structure Passage

Have you ever been to a rodeo? A rodeo is a North American sport. It came from the history of Mexican and American cowboys. Rodeos have events that include horses and cattle. The word *rodeo* is a Spanish word. It means "a roundup of cattle." Rodeos started between the cowboys to see who was the best. One of the first cowboy rodeos was held in Denver, Colorado in 1887. Today, there are professional competitions such as the National Finals Rodeo. This takes place in Las Vegas, Nevada.



Cowboys of the Old West needed skills and courage to complete their daily work. Those are shown in rodeos today. The five main events are calf roping, bull riding, steer wrestling, saddle bronco riding, and team roping. All of these events require a cowboy.

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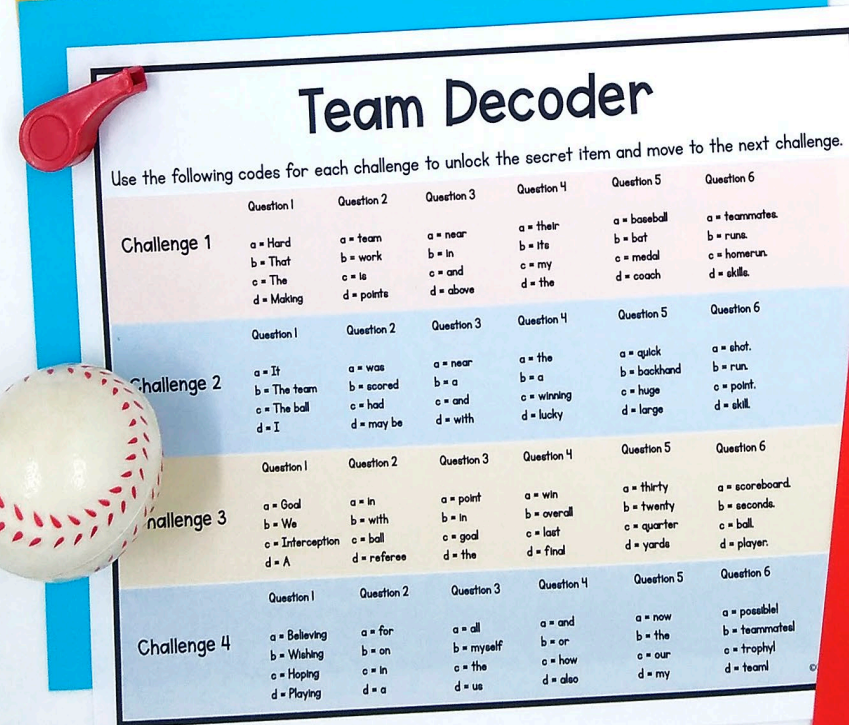

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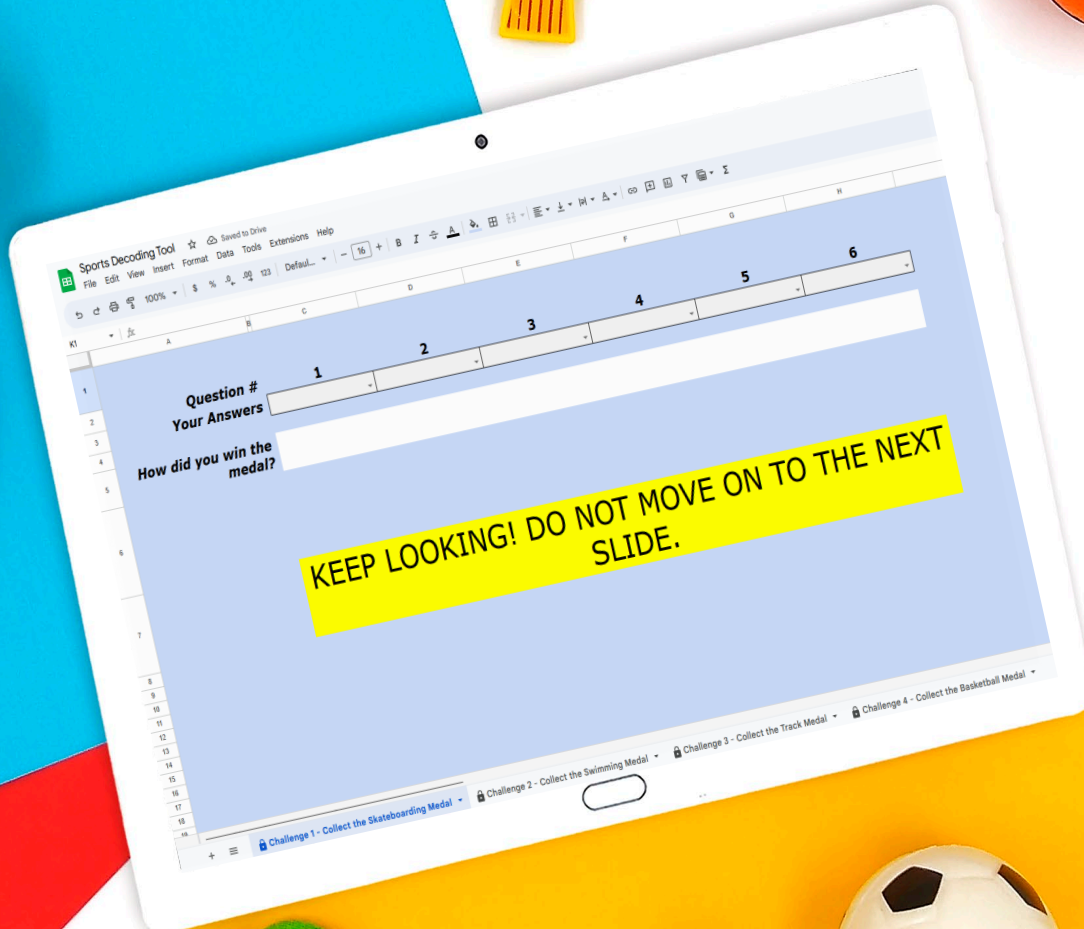
