A **construction site** is a place where something is being built. At construction sites there are workers, tools, and trucks that help with building.

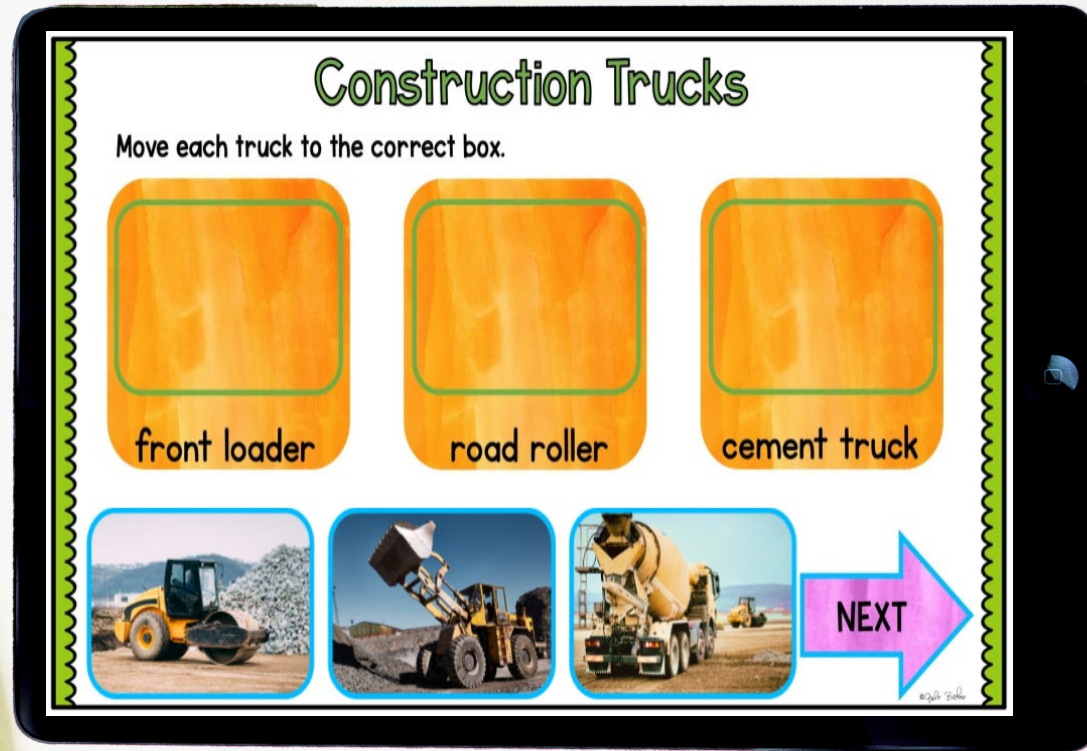

# ENGAGING & EDUCATIONAL MEDIA

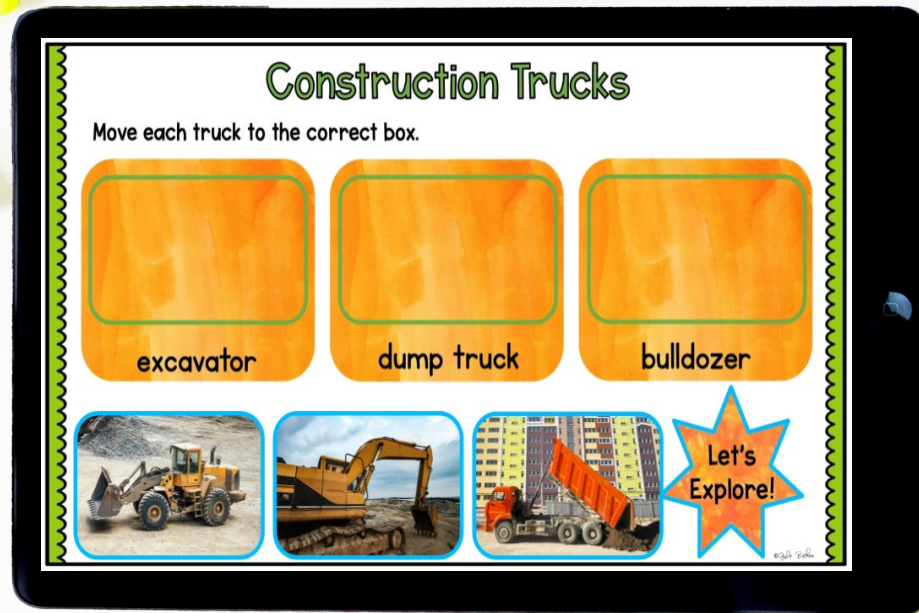
Videos incorporate social studies and reading skills. Includes standards-based interactive activities.
