People work together to care for the plants. The garden belongs to the whole community. People who help take care of the garden get to take home what grows there. There are many plants to share.

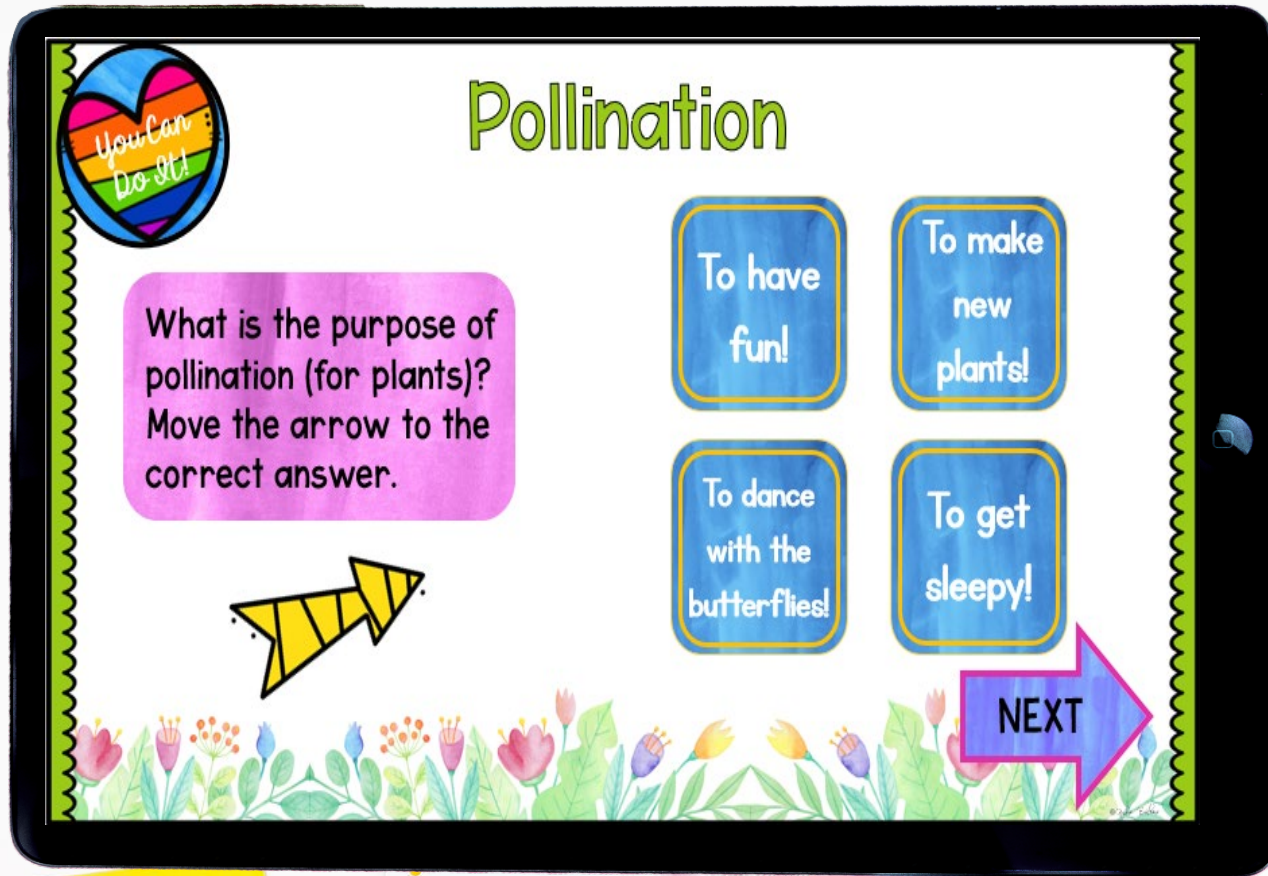

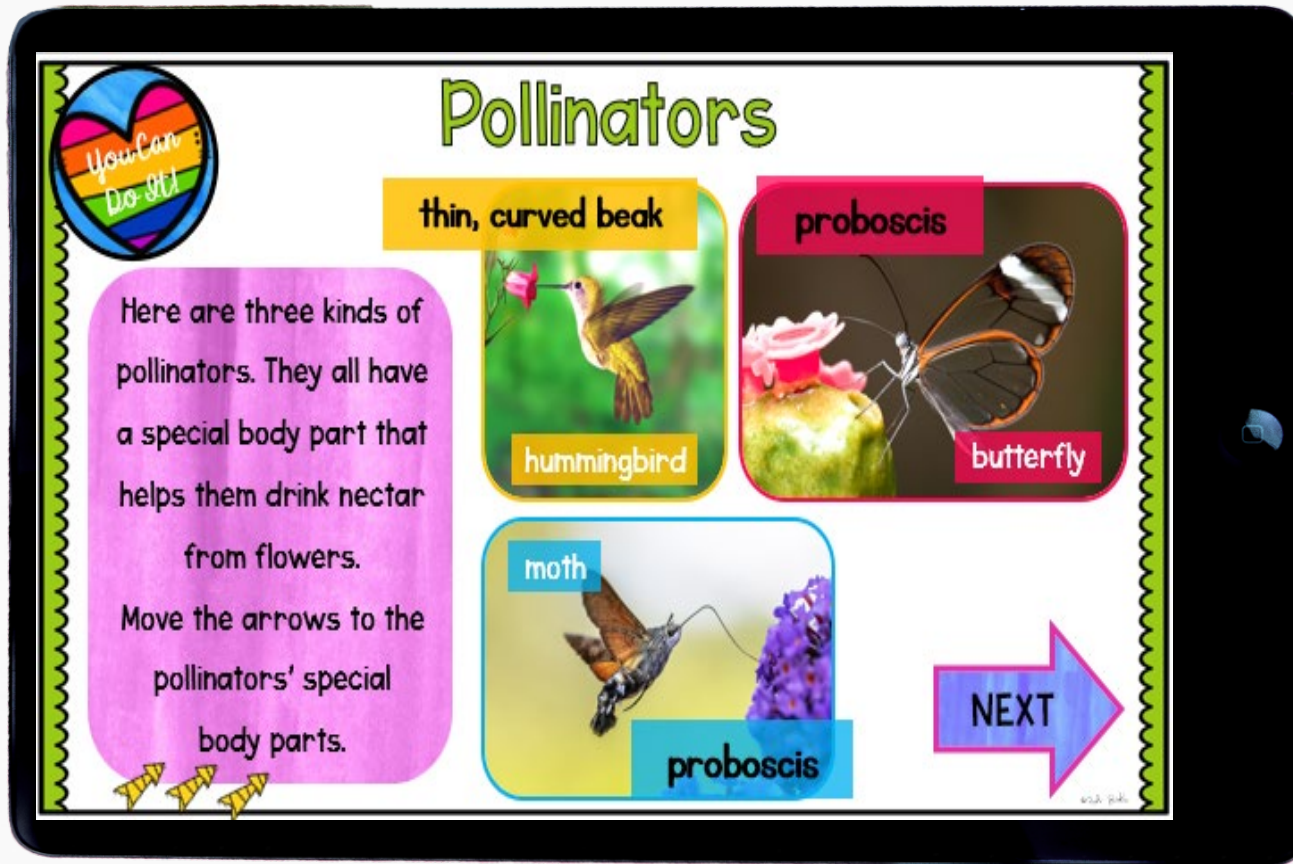




PROBLEM SOLVING

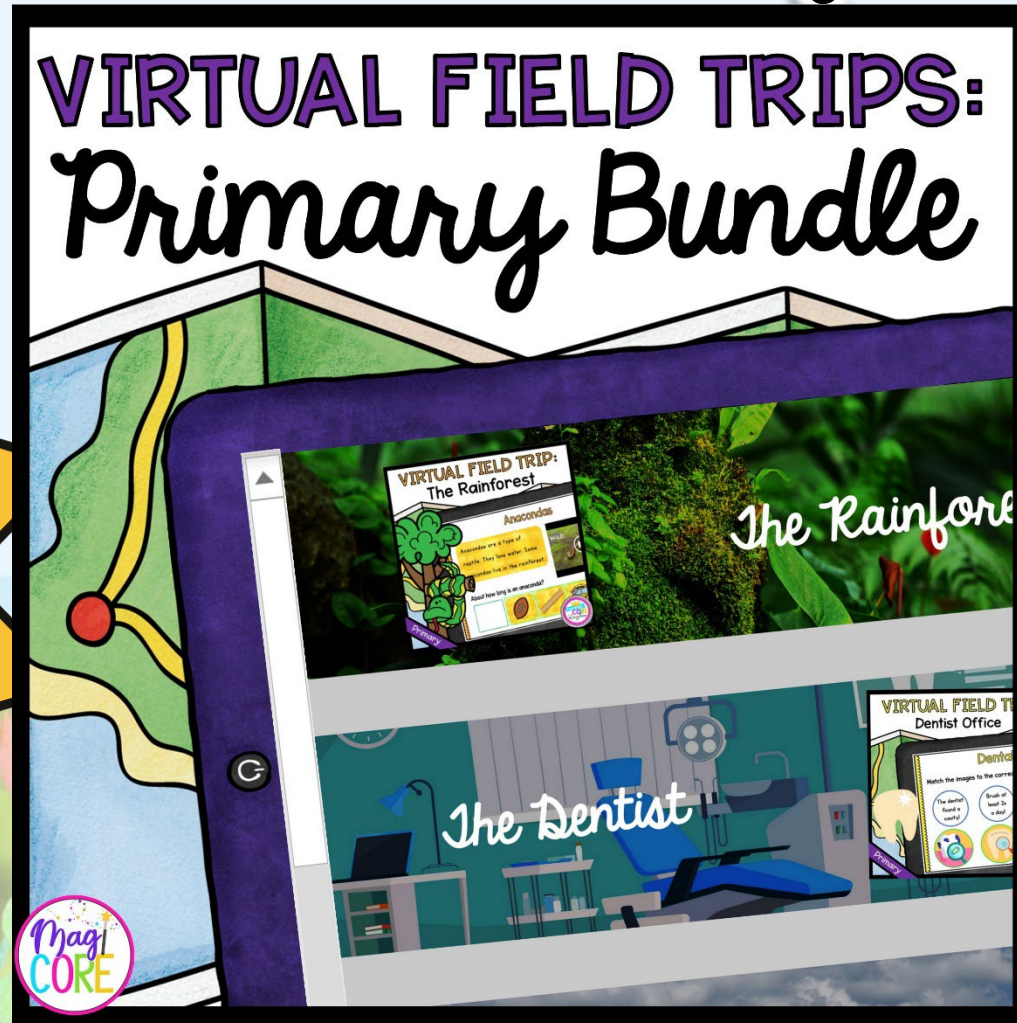
