Hamal: (studies his sneakers as he sits on a swing) We need a new challenge, Maksim. Neither of us can swing any higher or slide any faster or hang any longer. Maksim: (rocks slowly back and forth on the swing next to Hamal) You're right. Without a new challenge, this playaround is boring. Narrator: The boys scan the playground. The only pieces of equipment left are the seesaw, which isn't good for competition, and... the climbing wall. Leo, an older boy, is halfway up the climbing wall. For as long as the boys have been coming to the playground, Leo has always had the climbing wall to himself. He looks like a professional climber and someone you don't want to disturb.
