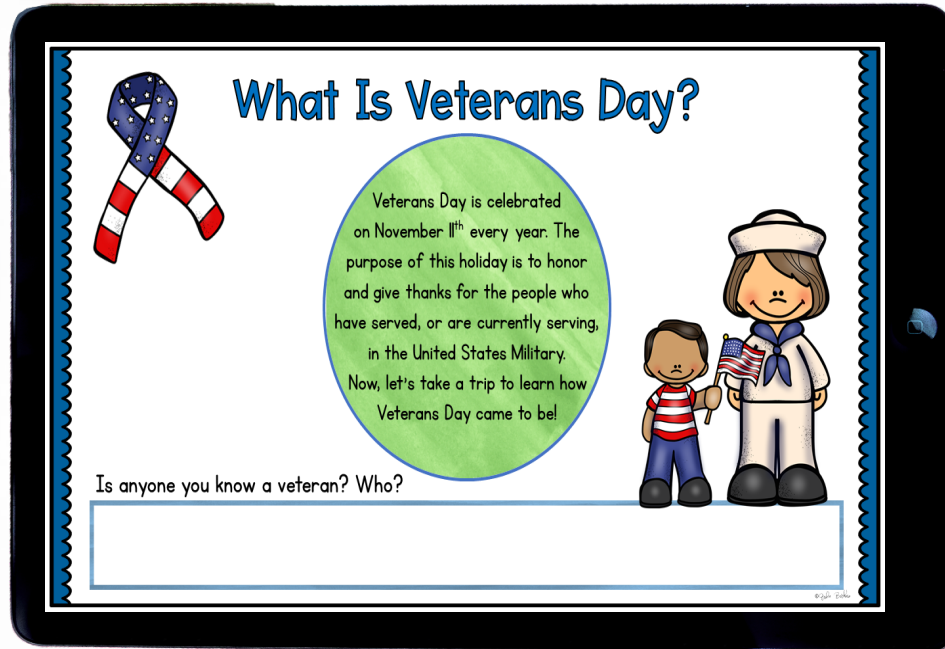



1. Why might it be important for members of the military to be strong and healthy?

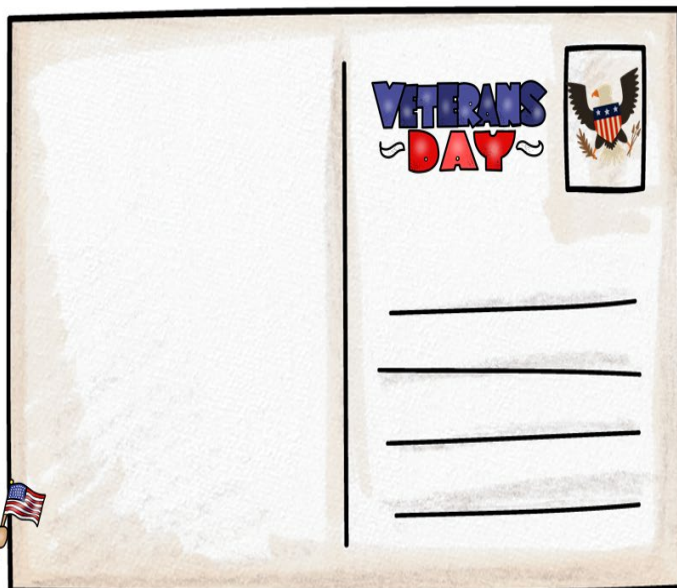
2. What branch of the military are you the most curious about? Why?

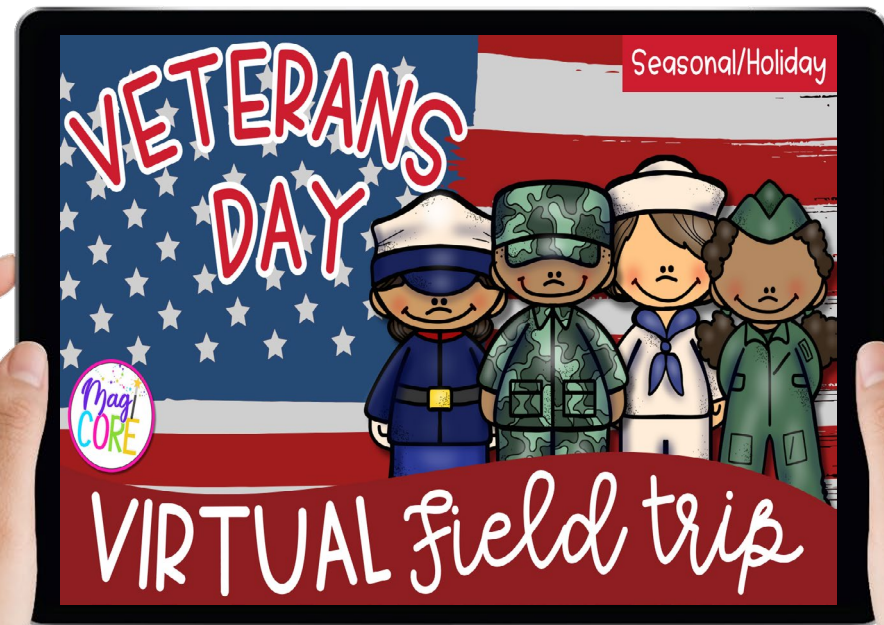
