

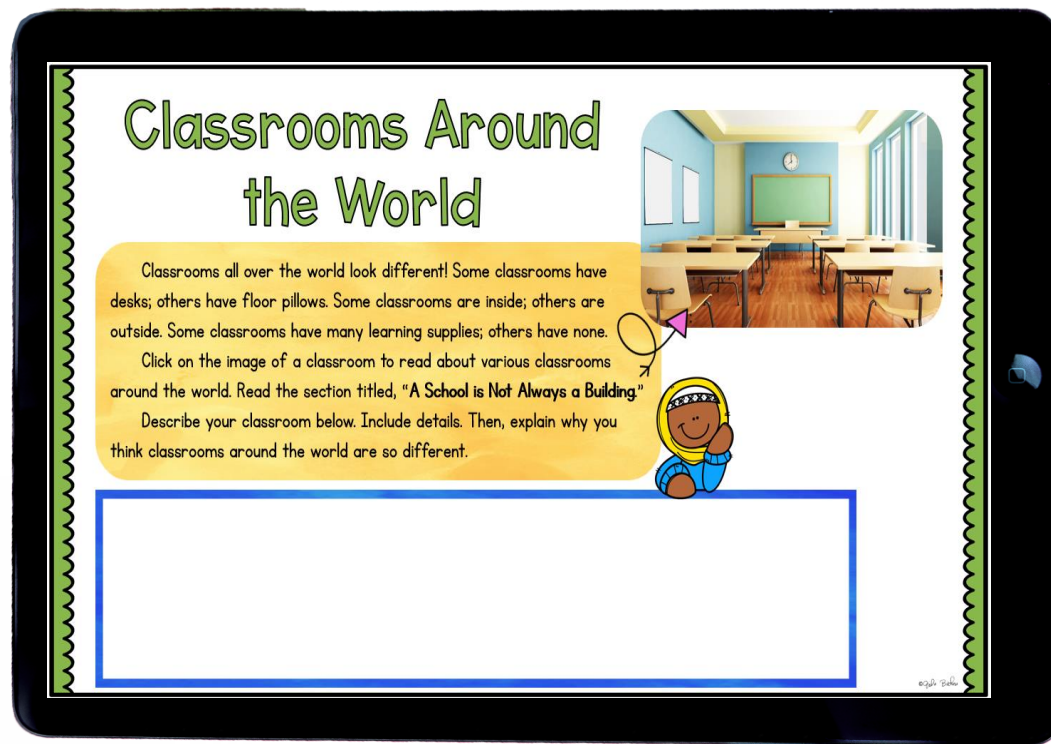

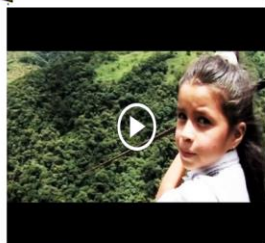

In some parts of the world, such as the Sahara Desert, children walk hours and hours to get to school. They must be careful as they travel past wild animal herds and unsafe terrain all by themselves. Much of the time, there is little to no water for their 2-6 hour long journey. It takes so long for some students to travel to school, and it is so unsafe, that many children spend the weeknights at their school instead of returning home each day.

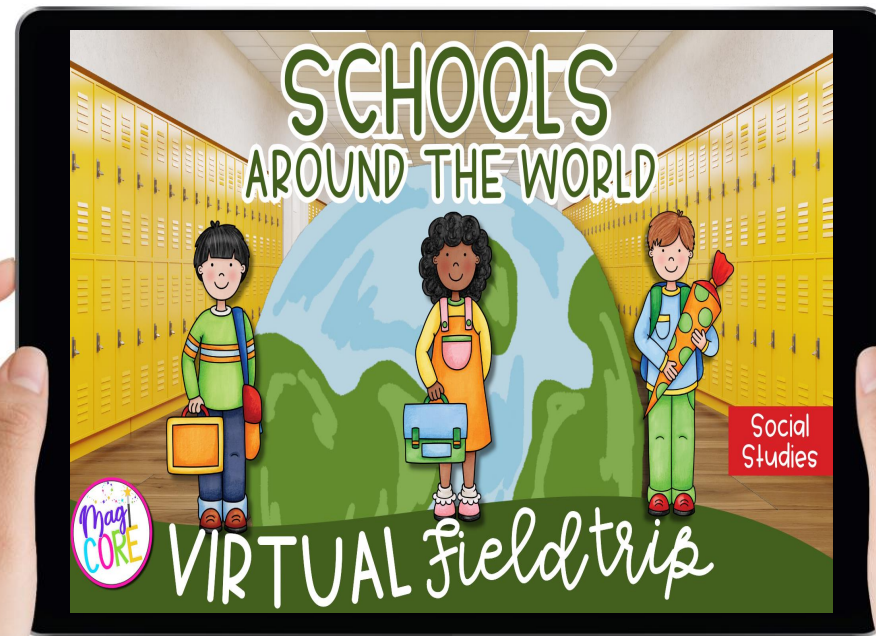
