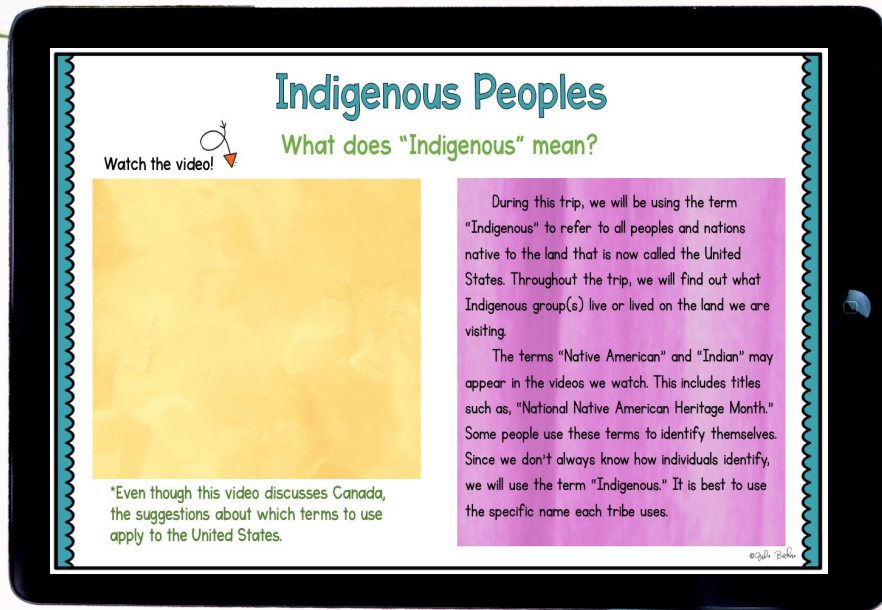

"Alaska Native" is a term that refers to all Indigenous Peoples of Alaska. There are five major Nations that are native to Alaska: Aleuts, Inupiat, Yuit, Athabascans, and Tlingit & Haida. Denali Borough, where "Molly from Denali" takes place, is Native land belonging to three other Indigenous Peoples: Tanana, Koyukon, and Denaina Ełnená.

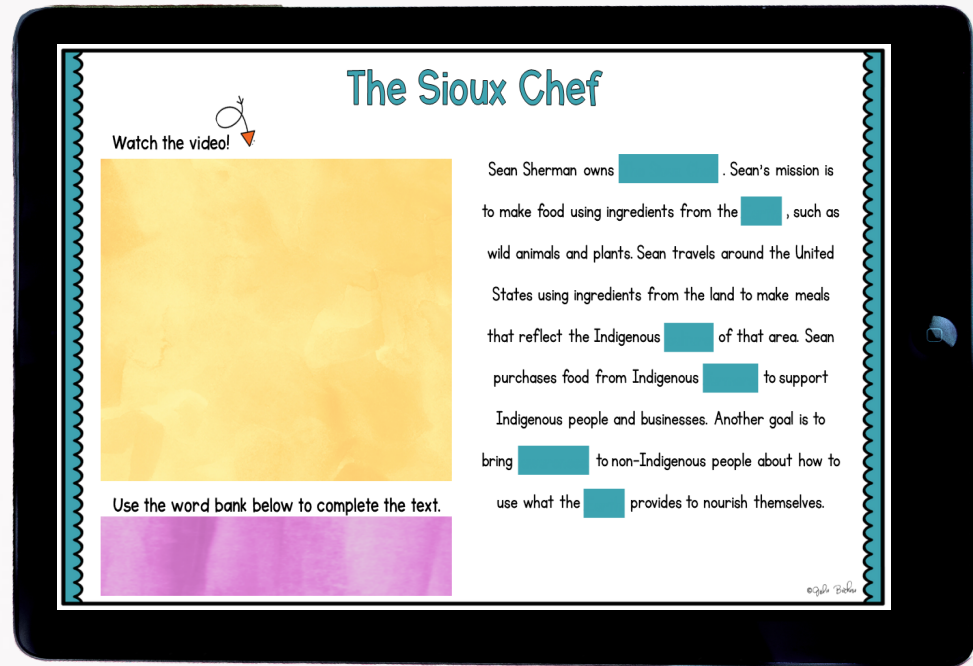

# INTERACTIVE MOVABLE PIECES

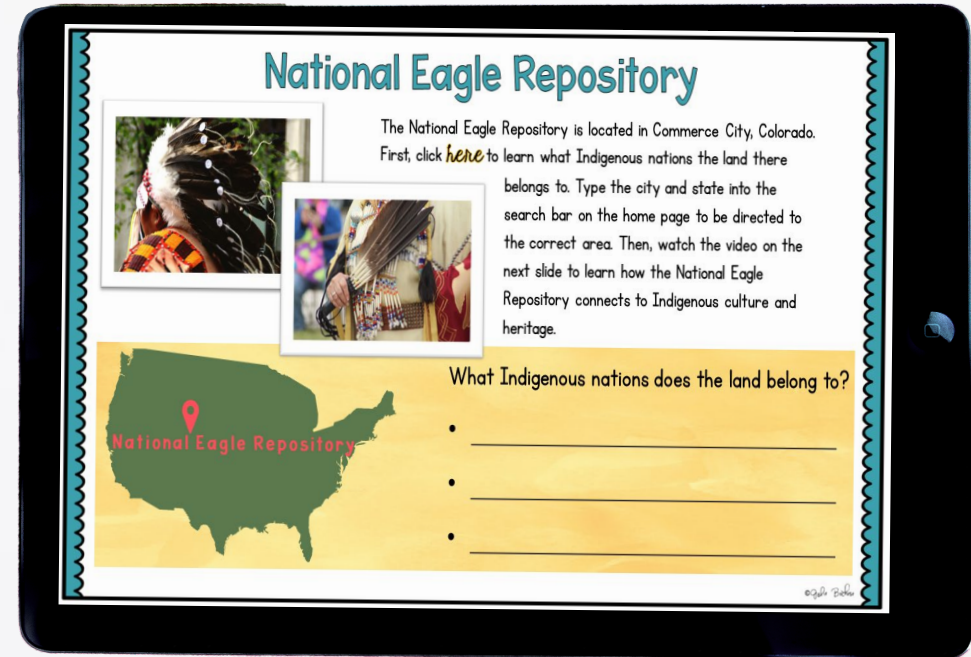
colorful, interactive movable

# ENGAGING & EDUCATIONAL MEDIA

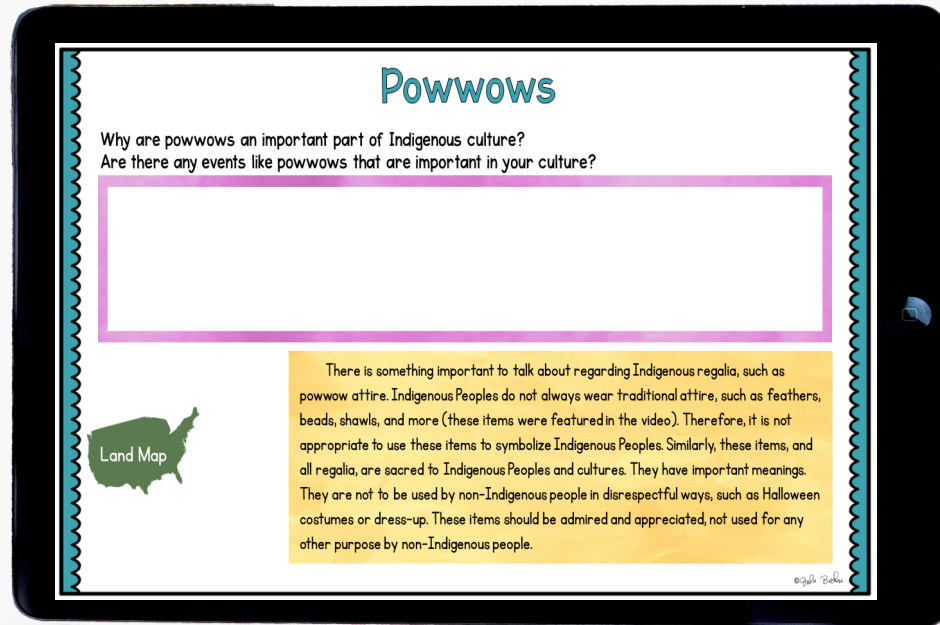
Short videos and media make learning engaging and fun.
