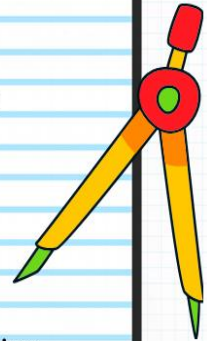
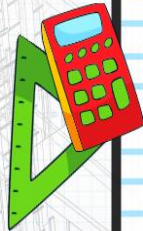
## WHAT IS AN ARCHITECT?

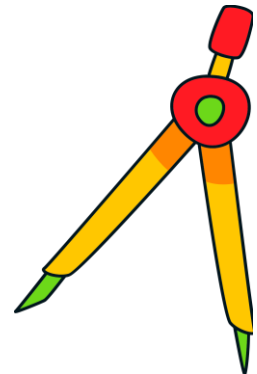
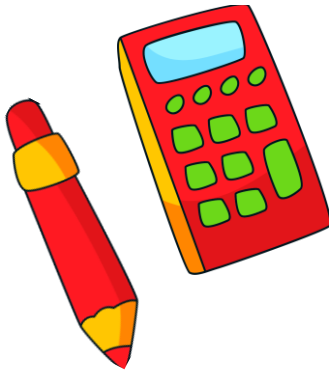
