INTERDISCIPLINARY

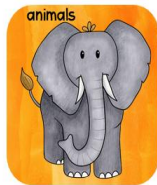

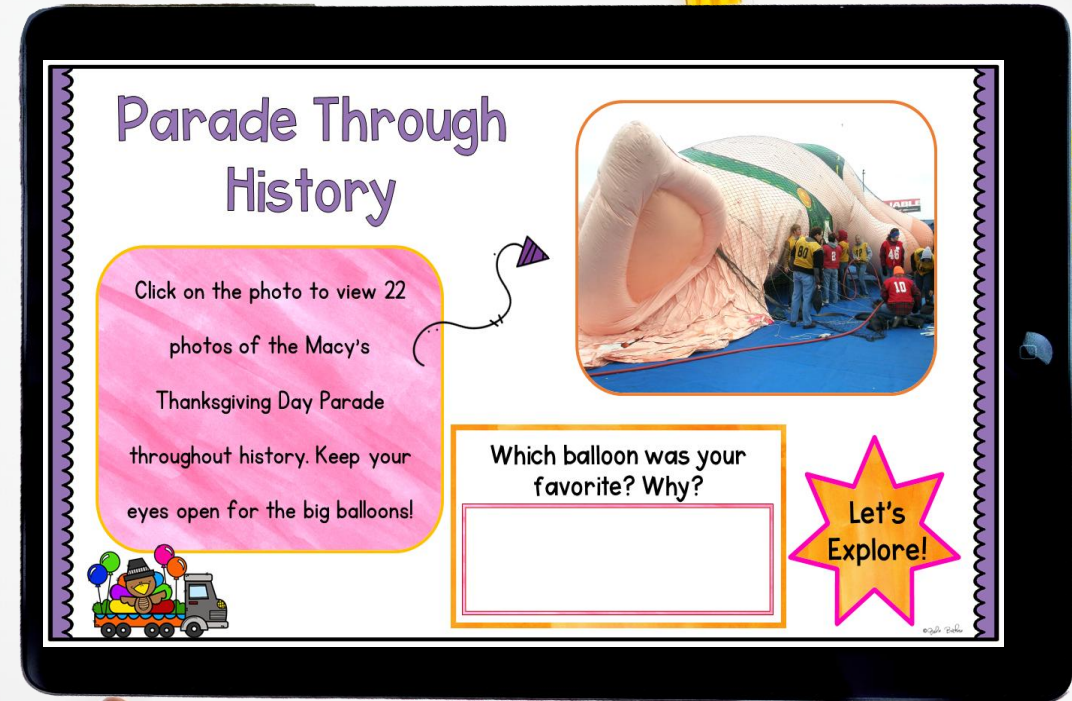

colorful, interactive movable pieces that children can drag and drop to solve problems, making learning more engaging and hands-on.

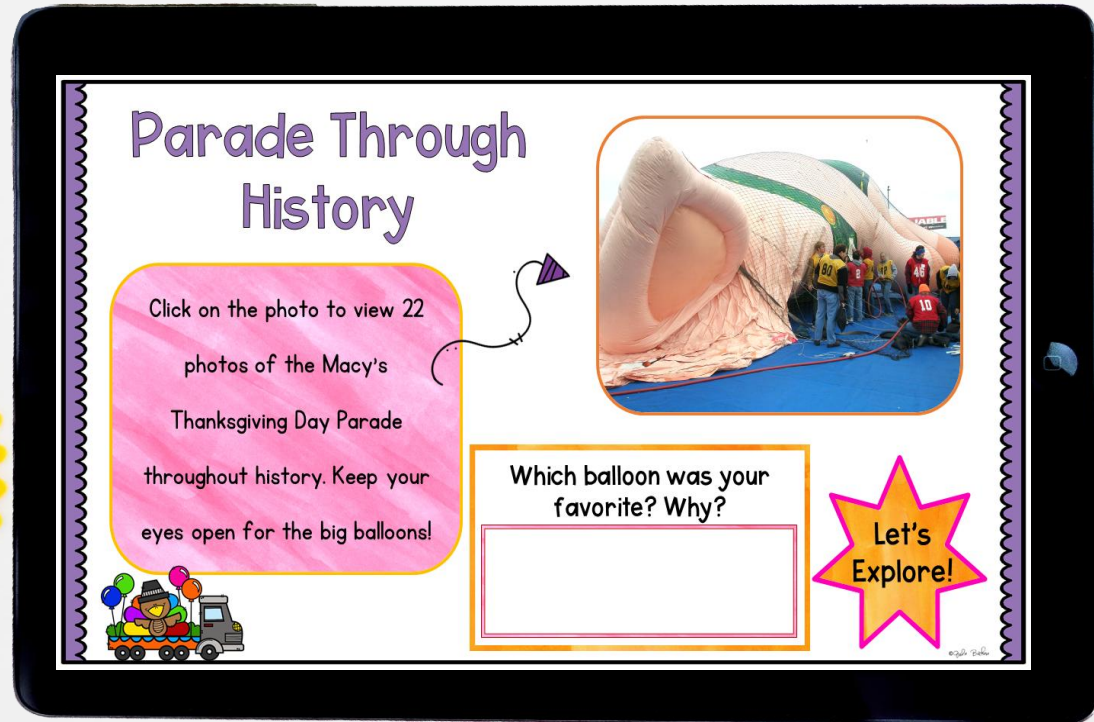
ENGAGING & EDUCATIONAL MEDIA

Which balloon was your favorite? Why?

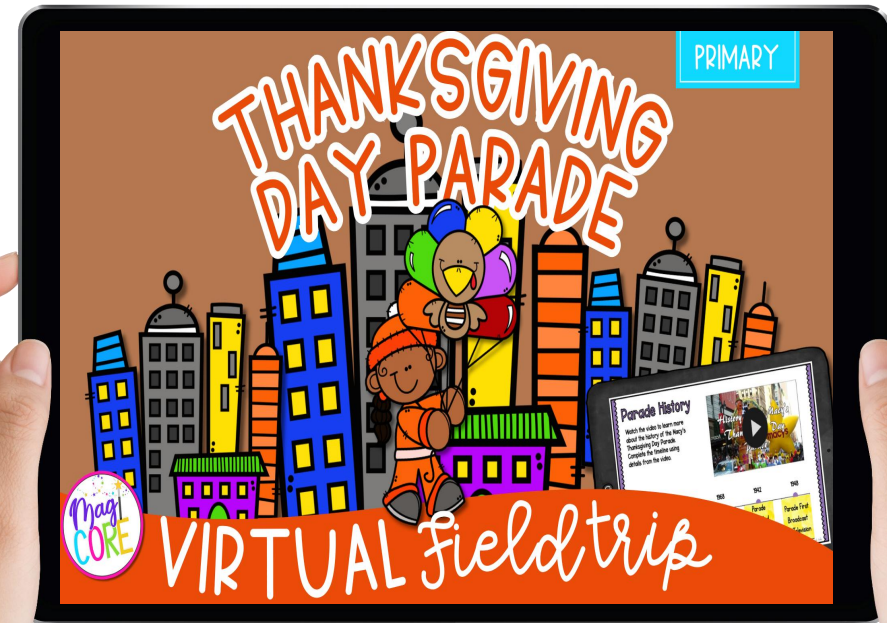
