
What is Earth Day


Diwali is a holiday. Many people enjoy the five days of Diwali. There are five religions that usually celebrate: Hinduism, Jain,
Buddhism, and Sikhs. For people who celebrate Diwali, it is the biggest holiday of the year. It is also the start of a new year.


