Gender Pay Gap in Professional Sports

The United States has the most successful international women's soccer team in the world - they're #1! The team has won 4 World Cup championships, which is more than any other country, and 4 more times than the U.S. men's

Despite their success, the players on the United States women's soccer team are consistently paid less than those on the men's team. At certain times in the past, the pay ratio has been 200:1, with men being paid 200 times the amount women were paid for playing the same game. At other times, the pay ratio has been closer to 2.5:1, with men being paid 2 1/2 times more than women.
