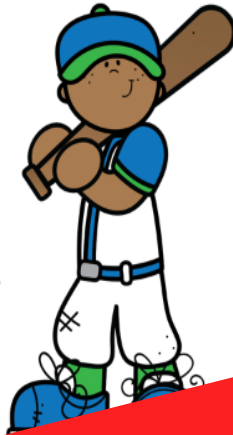

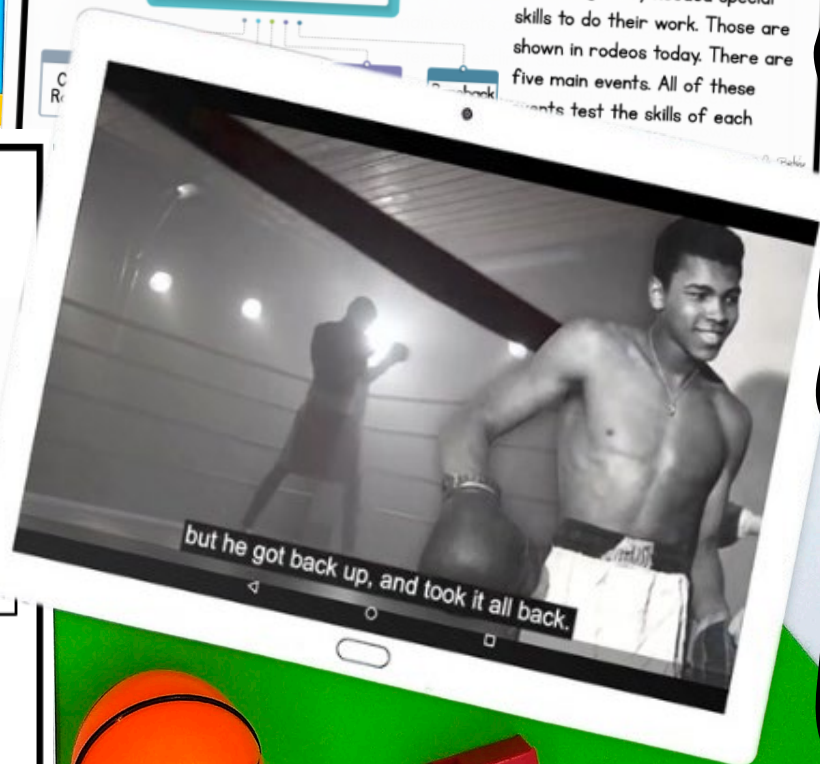
## Pages and Words Passa

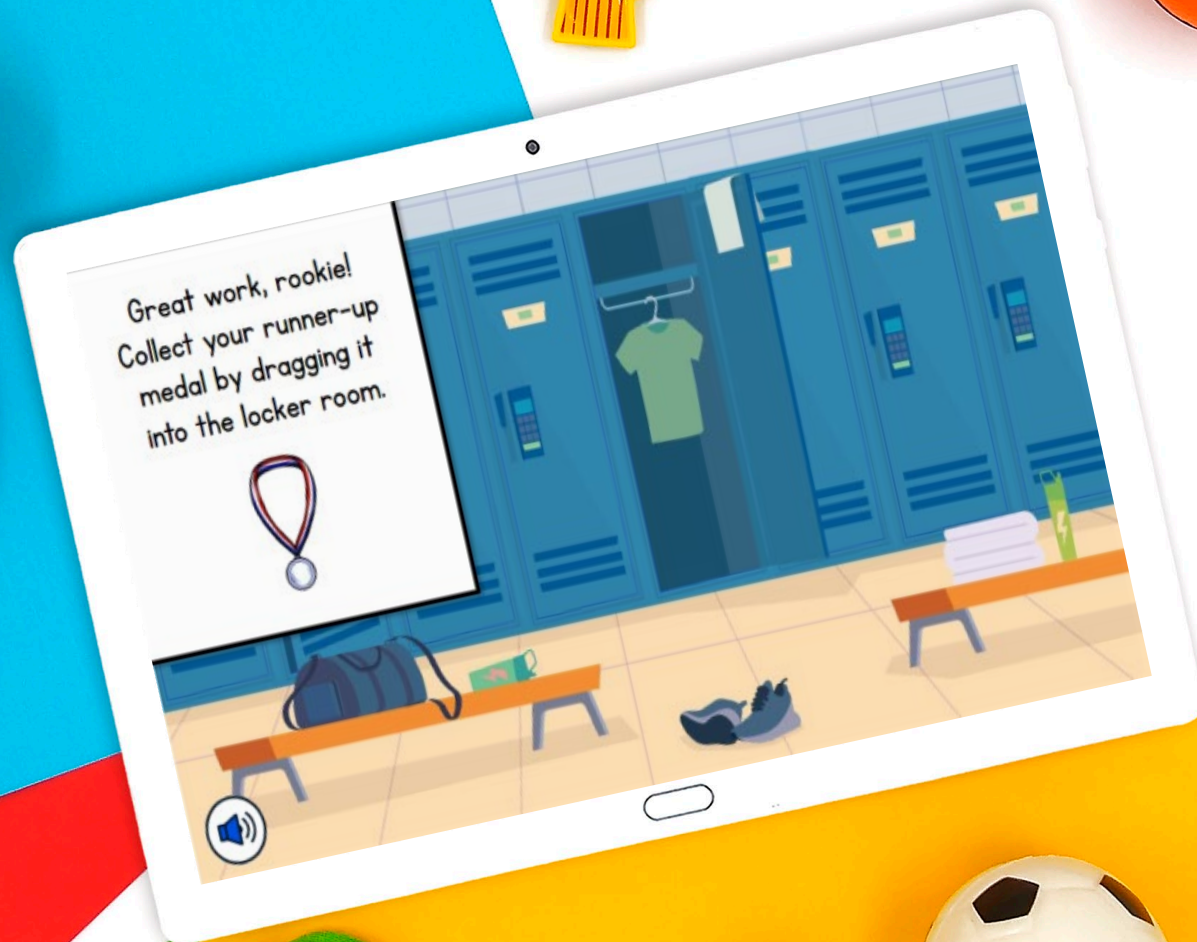



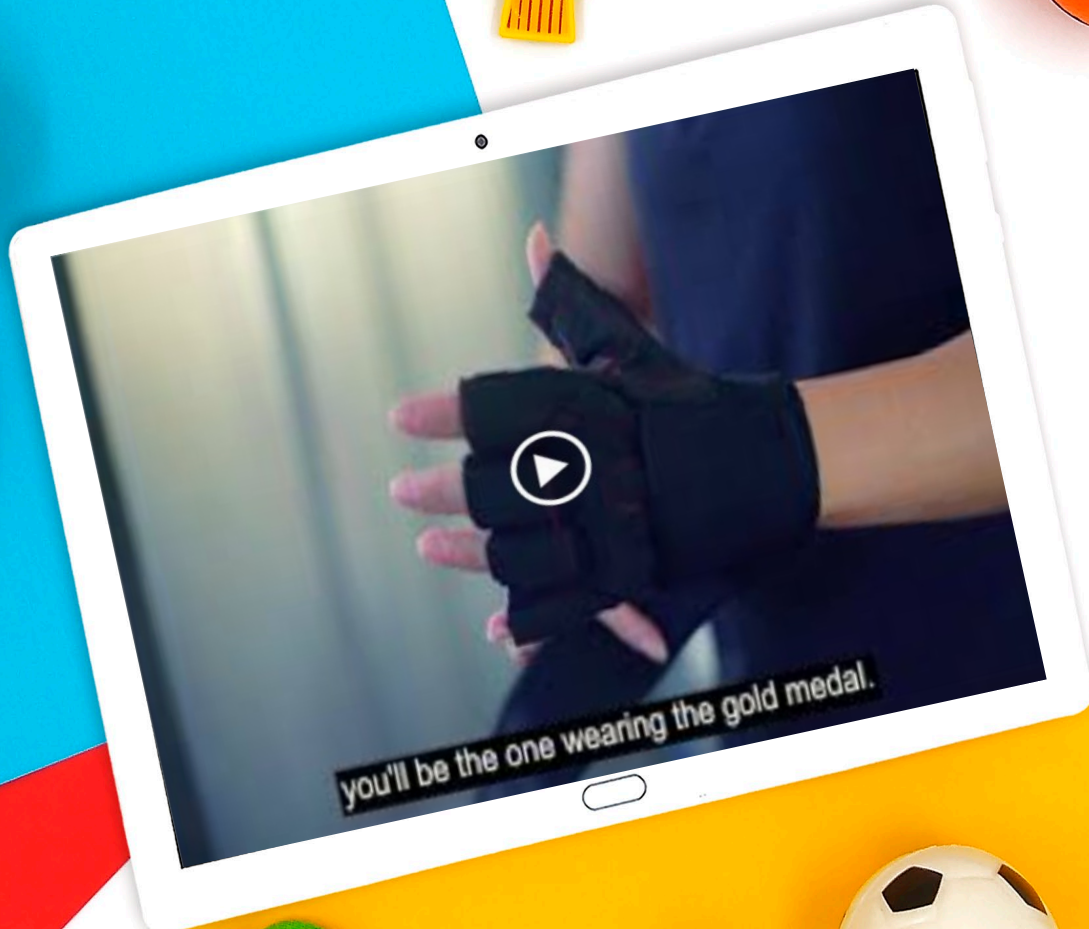
